## Beer magnate's murderer accused of violating parole

DENVER — Convicted murderer Joseph Corbett Jr., accused of violating parole, waived a probable cause hearing Monday and agreed to appear before the State Parole Board next month.

Corbett, wearing green jail clothing and black sneakers, appeared before Denver County Judge Robert Crew Jr. He spoke only one nearly inaudible word during the appearance.

"OK," Corbett said in a low voice

to no one in particular after his attorney told him the hearing was ended. He was then returned to the Denver city jail where he is being held pending a decision on his parole.

Corbett served 18 years in the Colorado State Penitentiary for the 1960 kidnap-murder of millionaire brewer Adolph Coors III. Corbett, who has maintained his innocence through the years, was released July 10 after three previous attempts at parole failed.

Corbett was released to the custody of his cousin in Redwood City, Calif., but was seen July 11 in Denver. Under conditions of his parole agreement, Corbett was not to leave the San Francisco Bay area without permission. He surrendered to authorities in Redwood City July 15.

Greg Walta, an assistant public defender who is representing Corbett, told Crew that Corbett would waive a hearing that would have determined if there was probable cause for Corbett to appear before the Parole Board.

Corbett, instead, will appear before the board in Denver at 9:30 a.m. Aug. 13, in a hearing that will determine if he violated conditions of his parole.

Walta and Ed Schlatter, an assistant public defender who also is representing Corbett, said they may request another hearing before Aug. 13 to obtain knowledge of evidence accumulated by the Denver district attorney's office, which is handling

the Corbett case.

Walta accused attorneys for the state of refusing to disclose the evidence against Corbett.

Handling the state's case against Corbett were Susan Trout of the Denver district attorney's office and Paul Korda, a deputy district attorney from Jefferson County where Corbett was convicted of the Coors murder in 1961.

Trout and Korda said the public defenders apparently wish to know what evidence the state has against Corbett. Korda said the state's damaging evidence was withheld from what he saw Corbett in Denver July 11. He said the witnesses might testify at the Aug. 13 hearing.

"We will be presenting evidence of parole violation," Korda said. "We will recommend revocation."

Walta has said he will argue that Corbett was under the strain of a extreme publicity and should not have his parole revoked for a brief disappearance.

Corbett told authorities in California and Colorado that he returned to Denver for only about four hours July 11 to withdraw \$1,216 from a bank account, then returned to the San Francisco Bay area and wandered around like a bewildered tourist.

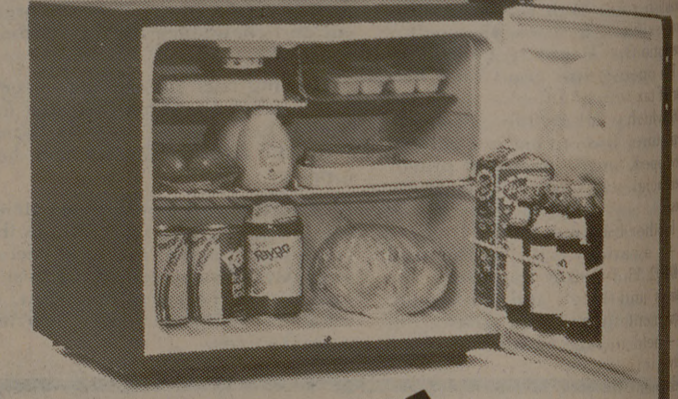
