Government helped Citygo's profits

TULSA, Okla. — One of the reasons for Cities Service Co.'s 90 percent increase in profits is the federal government's decision to allow higher gasoline prices, company officials said Wednesday.

Robert V. Sellers, chairman and chief executive officer, said Wednesday the Tulsa-headquartered company earned \$76.7 million for

the second quarter of 1979, up from the \$40.4 million earned during the second quarter of 1978.

Cities Service markets most of its petroleum products on the East Coast under the Citygo name and is ranked 16th or 17th among the top 20 domestic oil companies, said company spokesman Kent Young.

Young said one of the primary reasons for the increased profit was

the relaxation of federal price controls on petroleum products and the resulting higher gasoline prices.

Sellers said even without the "enactment of a so-called windfall profits tax" the federal government "was one of the largest benefactors of Cities Service's financial results" because of the excise tax paid on the higher gasoline prices.

Profits for the second quarter,

however, were down 2 percent from the first quarter of 1979, Sellers said.

"Increased profits in the first half of the year resulted from improved performance in three major business segments: energy resources; refining, marketing and transportation; and mineral," Sellers said.

The over-all improved earnings are due to successes in oil exploration and development, refining and marketing, the company's copper

mining interests and a large recovery project in Canada, Sellers said.

Inventories of crude oil and refined products, however, have depleted to "critically low levels, an attempt to meet increased demand," Sellers said.

The company's refineries are operating at 91 percent capacity the first half of the year and the times processed were up 5 percent over 1978, Sellers said.

Pirates roaming the Illinois River no Bluebeard's

TALHEQUAH, Okla. — They may not act like baroque swashbucklers of the high seas, but river pirates along the Illinois River's curving banks are causing concern among local business and law enforcement officers.

Archie Peyton, operator of the largest of several canoe rental businesses along the Illinois River, is warning his patrons to beware of men lurking along the river's edge.

He says the pirates scurry along the river bank, scuttle a canoe and then dive for belongings lost in the river's depths.

"They put a log out over the river, then wait for canoes to hit the tip over," Peyton said. "Then they dive for what fell out of the canoes."

He said the pirates are selective in choosing a location to watch tourists floating down the generally slow-moving river.

Peyton said pirates' favorite spots appear to be deeper, more moving sections of the river where inexperienced paddlers are best not to dive for their belongings.

Bruce Olson, a ranger assigned to patrol the river, says there have been at least three pirating incidents along the Illinois River in recent weeks and the bandits are "using discretion on who they topple over. They are picking on the helpless."

He said there are just three rangers to patrol the Illinois River and that's not enough to prevent pirating.

Olson said he considers the pirates fair game for all law enforcement agencies in Cherokee County.

Three years ago, according to one canoe rental operator, pirating became so bad on the river that a crew of vigilantes was sent to drive the pirates out of their hidden lairs.

They apparently succeeded in breaking up pirate gangs, but not from stopping others from joining the centuries-old profession of attacking water craft.
