Hearings open on DC-10 crash

ROSEMONT, Ill. — The National Transportation Safety Board opened hearings Monday to determine the probable cause of the nation's worst aircraft disaster — the May 25 crash of an American Airlines DC-10 in which 273 people were killed.
The hearings, scheduled for last two weeks, are being held only to determine cause and will not conduct an inquiry into liability, said Elwood Driver, vice chairman of the NTSB.
In opening remarks, Driver said the hearings will focus basically on why an engine mounting assembly called a pylon failed, leading to the separation of the plane's left engine on takeoff.
He said they also will examine the effect of the loss of the pylon engine on the aircraft's fuel system, electrical system and the plane's capability to maintain altitude.
Edward D. Dreifus, investigator-in-charge, said an investigation date has shown that Flight 191, within takeoff weight and limitations at the time of takeoff, said the last stable thrust engine — the engine that failed — was recorded two seconds before lift-off.
One second earlier, the "Damn," was uttered in the cockpit and shortly thereafter the voice recorded stopped.
The wide-bodied jet moments later in a nearby field 1 1/2 miles northwest of International Airport.
"There was almost total disintegration of the aircraft structure, crash and impact forces were survivable," Dreifus said.
Driver said about five members of both technical experts and witnesses, would testify each day.
