Nixon trip: China check-up

PEKING — Former President Richard Nixon returned to China Monday, scene of his greatest diplomatic triumph, and said Chinese-American friendship is vital for survival of both countries and the peace of the world.

Nixon arrived at Peking airport aboard a jetliner of Civil Aviation Authority of China. No top-level Chinese were at the airport to meet him.

Relaxed and smiling, Nixon chatted briefly with reporters before taking an official limousine to one of Peking's numerous guest houses for foreign dignitaries.

"This is my third visit to China," Nixon said. "I look forward to meeting again those leaders I met before, and meeting some of the other leaders whom I have not met."

"The purpose of my visit is to be brought up to date on the relations between the two countries, and to be able to see what progress is being made, and will be made in the future," Nixon said.

Nixon is expected to confer with Chinese Vice Premier Deng Xiaoping, and possibly with Premier and

Communist Party Chairman Hua Guofeng.

Nixon said he thought his visit, which is expected to last four days, "will demonstrate that in the election campaign (in the United States) which is beginning to heat up that (China) is one issue on which, with very few exceptions, there will not be a division between the two parties."

Afghan head resigns; shoot-out reported

NEW DELHI, India — Former Afghanistan President Nor Mohammad Taraki was forced out of power by his successor and may have been wounded in the culmination of a long-standing personal power struggle, diplomatic sources said Monday.

Prime Minister Hafizollah Amin Sunday assumed control of Afghanistan, which has been torn by civil strife between Moslems and the pro-Moscow communist regime.

Visitors who returned to New Delhi during the weekend from Kabul said Monday Taraki, 62, may have been wounded in a shoot-out coup Friday.

World briefs

Three-bus crash kills seven in Mexico

MEXICO CITY — At least seven people died and 15 were seriously injured early Monday in a three-bus pileup on a highway 6 miles east of Mexico City, federal highway police said.

Police said the accident occurred when the first bus in a three-bus caravan went out of control around a snaking curve on the road to the city of Puebla. The other two buses could not stop in time and piled on top of each other.

Nearly a dozen Red Cross rescue squads rushed to the scene of the accident and pulled out seven bodies and at least 15 injured from the twisted remains of the vehicles, police said.

Nerve gas found; evacuation ordered

HAMBURG, West Germany — Authorities Monday evacuated 80 people from their homes and closed 60 factories near an abandoned explosives factory, where military experts began clearing out more than 500 tons of munitions and poison gas.

Military experts in gas masks carried away the highly poisonous C.A. Gas, a nerve gas manufactured during World War II and found in the deserted compound.

Police learned of the arms and gas cache after a boy was killed and two others severely injured while playing with explosives. The boys had entered the factory area through a broken fence.

Texas woman gets 1 year on heroin count

SINGAPORE — A Texas woman broke out in sobs Monday when she was sentenced to 12 months in prison on a conviction of possessing heroin while trying to board an airliner for San Francisco last month.

Elene Calloway Finley of Houston was originally charged with trafficking in narcotics, which carries the mandatory death sentence on conviction.

Government witnesses, however, testified in earlier court appearances that final analysis of the drugs taken from her amounted to less than 15 grams and the charge was reduced to possession.

8 flee East Germany in hand-made balloon

NAILA, West Germany — They yearned for freedom and saw no other way out. The women sewed pieces of sheets and nylon together and the men, one a government-trained aircraft mechanic, assembled the parts, hiding them in the basement.

Then four adults and four children took flight on their hand-made balloon and escaped to West Germany.

It was the first escape to West Germany ever made in a balloon. The craft, its burning gas ignited by the early Sunday darkness, carried the two East German families to the edge of a woods, just 100 yards from the mine fields on the East German border.

The family of a Hans-Peter Strelzik, a 31-year-old aircraft mechanic who learned his trade in the German Air Force, and the family of bricklayer Guenter Wetzel, succeeded in what was their second escape attempt in a homemade air balloon.

"There was no other possibility of escaping," Strelzik told reporters. Naila, a Bavarian town five miles west of West Germany.

The balloon, as the gas ran out, made a sudden, hard landing. Naila at 2:40 a.m. Sunday on the edge of a woods, just 100 yards from a high tension wire.

"We were skeptical about whether we were in the West, the boys and our wives hid in the woods and Guenter and I went scouting," Strelzik said.

A policeman who encountered them said, "They had the fear death in their eyes. They were sure they were in the West."

Strelzik said an attempt to flee July 3 failed when their balloon went down about 200 yards from the border. They were not caught. East German border guards contacted the balloon.
