


Engineer student's paper wins
 Linda McCown, a senior in industrial engineering, won the 1979 student paper competition sponsored by the Texas A&M Student Chapter of the Human Factors Society. The formal presentation was made by Dr. Newton C. Ellis, industrial engineering department head and a Fellow in the Human Factors Society. A plaque recognizing achievement in winning the first competition was provided by Stephen Hottman, president of the student chapter. It will be displayed in the industrial engineering office hallway, and subsequent winners' names will be added on bronze plates. McCown's paper, "The Effects of Fatigue on Hand Steadiness," represents a practical investigation of theory proposed by B. M. Lance and D. B. Chaffin in 1971. McCown conducted an experiment involving a test of hand steadiness under fatigued and unfatigued conditions. The incompatibility of muscular exertion and fine muscular control was shown by more errors in the hand steadiness test when the muscles were tired. A short rest period was shown to be enough to restore performance levels.
