Eight \$100 prizes and two \$25 honorable mentions will be presented at a Nov. 2 awards ceremony. The program will include an address by Myers Raymer, restorer and binder of rare books. Raymer owns Bookcrafters shop in Houston. Entries in the Seventh Student Book Collectors Contest will be accepted until Oct. 19 from students

currently enrolled at Texas A&M. Contest rules and entry forms are available at the Sterling C. Evans Library. An entry consists of an annotated bibliography of 25 titles from a collection, a short statement describing the collection and a completed entry form. Finalists will be asked to bring the 25 books for final judging to the contest committee whose members are A&M librarians.
