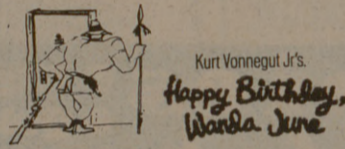

Imposters' schemes revealed in 3 states

LUBBOCK — Attempts by con men to bilk Social Security recipients out of their savings have been reported in three states in recent weeks, according to the district manager for the Social Security Administration.

Laura Peacock says impostors posing as Social Security Administration workers have failed in two reported attempts in Lubbock, but have been successful elsewhere.

An 87-year-old New Mexico man recently gave \$1,358 to a man who told the victim he would get him additional benefits, Peacock said.

"As soon as the con man got the

man's savings, he promptly disappeared," she said, adding that a second man was relieved of \$800 in a similar scheme the same day.

A week earlier, said Peacock, \$600 was taken from another man and a couple in Broken Bow, Okla., lost \$260 to two men posing as Social Security representatives.

"Offices in McAlester, Hugo and Poteau, Okla., report several persons posing as Social Security representatives tried to gain entrance to homes in that area," she said. "Once inside, the impostors tried to steal money and valuables. Some tried to sell worthless junk to the homeowners."

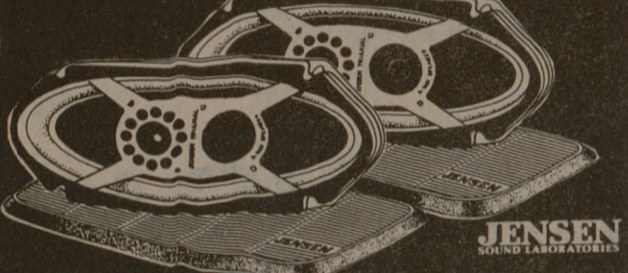
