

# Minors in bars prevalent problem

Wayne is big for his age. He is more than six feet tall and weighs about 185 pounds.  
Without looking at his driver's license, one cannot be sure of his true age. During a recent visit in College Station, Wayne's age, which is 16, could have gotten him in trouble.  
He and his friends went to a local beer hall where he drank about 12 beers.  
One of his friends said Wayne had no trouble getting into the club. "Wayne just waited until there were a lot of people at the door and then just walked right in."  
Wayne is not the only minor in College Station that sneaks into nightclubs or dancehalls. This is because where college students go, high school students want to go too, said Jim Bunden of Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission (TABC).  
The fact that minors sometimes are able to purchase liquor could mean trouble for both the minor and the licensee who sold it, Bunden said.  
The minor, if caught, can be punished. He or she can either be turned over to the juvenile authorities or to parents, Bunden said. If the person is 17, he could be sent to jail.  
The business holding the liquor license where the minor purchased the liquor stands a good chance of having his license revoked or suspended, Bunden said.  
It is the licensee's responsibility to keep minors out, Bunden said. Some type of valid identification, such as a driver's license, should be required to enter all local nightclubs. Many local clubs have a doorman for this purpose.  
Gary Seaback, owner of Studio 2818, said the only way minors can enter his club is with a fake identification card.  
At Spectrum, a new disco in town, everyone who looks less than 31 is asked for identification, an employee said. If a person looks under 21, sometimes he must produce kinds of identification.  
The employee said if there is doubt about validity of the identification, the patron is asked for his name, which is compared one on the driver's license.  
Another way the TABC sees avoid admitting minors using undercover men into club club. If he sees someone appears to be under age, an employee is told to check his identification again.  
When the TABC receives a complaint from parents who think their child is purchasing liquor at a local club, an officer is sent to check the club. If the minor is purchasing liquor, he or she is apprehended.  
The local police are authorized to arrest any minor drinking liquor without the parents or guardian present, Bunden said.  
The police make frequent checks of the local clubs to check identification. If the police find enough, the minors are taken away, Seaback said.  
Through the aid of the police, TABC and undercover men, the problem with minors drinking locally is decreasing, Bunden said. "It exists. It's a game. We enforce the law, but you can't catch everyone."

# Long drive doesn't stop top minister

The Rev. James Humphries works at a Corpus Christi ministry during the week and each 268-mile round trip each week to serve as pastor of the Baptist Church in Wilson County has been named Texas Minister of the Year.  
Announcement of the honor was made during the closing session of the 34th annual Town and Country Church Conference, which drew more than 150 ministers to the A&M University.  
Del Deterling, southwest representative of Progressive Farmer magazine made the presentation. Deterling said the award honors ministers whose churches for "continued aggressive participation in community activities and for encouragement of agricultural improvement."  
For the past 10 years, Humphries has commuted to the Marble Baptist Church located between Floresville and Stockdale, Texas with a variety of church and community activities.  
The minister receives no salary for his work at the church, but is reimbursed for his travel and provided a small parsonage. Humphries and his employer, Chem Oil Co., work out his schedule so that he can attend regular church business.  
Humphries began preaching in 1953 at Baptist Temple in Corpus Christi, and was ordained at the church in 1955.  
He later served as pastor of Encinal Baptist Church, located near the boundary line of Llaneta and Webb Counties, for seven years before accepting his present church.

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
