Coffeehouse offers Aggie auditions

The MSC Basement Coffeehouse is offering aspiring student musicians a chance to show their talents before groups of music-loving A&M University students.

The committee holds talent auditions in the Basement after each of its regular meetings. Ava King, publicity director for the committee, said that anyone interested in auditioning for the Basement should contact Greg Marks, the program director.

A panel of ten judges, all committee members, evaluate each performance. Performances are judged on musicianship and professionalism, interpretation of material, and rapport with the audience. If the act has its own equipment, they are judged on technical ability.

In addition to the Basement Coffeehouse, the committee arranges for outdoor shows. These consist of students who have been formed in connection with the committee, and developed the professionalism needed to perform before the large groups of students who gather to hear the outdoor performances.

The Basement Coffeehouse provided a first step into the entertainment world for many A&M students. Among those who have gone on to greater popularity is Jimmy Donahue, the lead singer of the group called Morning, a three-piece band that started at A&M in 1970.

Donahue managed to get a audition on a Friday night, after the main group had played. Instead of the few minutes he expected, he sang for 40 minutes, Donahue said.

Brad Bayliss, of the team Bayliss and Schulte, said he first auditioned in 1978 and had his performance at one of the outdoor concerts.

Many types of acts audition at the Basement, King said. Members have listened to everything from country and western to punk rock. She added that the judges have watched jugglers and magicians, too.

Lyle Lovett, who is not a member of the committee, but sometimes performs for the Basement, said he'd like to see the Basement become a coffeehouse again to provide the students with the best of music that the community does not have. Lovett, who was an official in the committee in 1978, said the Basement Coffeehouse was the perfect place for people to come and listen to music. "It's the most place around to listen and a place to try out new material because people do listen," he said.

The name of the Basement Coffeehouse is confusing, he said, because it's not really in the basement. Before the new MSC was built, the Basement Coffeehouse was sectioned-off corner of the basement of the previous building. It's now located outside the MSC, behind the Post Office.

The Basement Coffeehouse is distinct in some ways, Bayliss said. The Basement Coffeehouse is one of a few coffeehouses located on a university campus that doesn't serve alcoholic drinks, King said. She added that plans are under way to enlarge the concession area and provide customers with non-alcoholic drinks, she said.
