MIDLAND — More than 1,200 persons gathered Tuesday for a sun-washed, pro-oil industry rally on the county courthouse grounds and heard actress Jane Fonda labeled an enemy of free enterprise.

The rally, co-sponsored by the West Texas Geological Society and the Permian Basin Petroleum Association, preceded by a day a series "Stop the Oil Profiteers" anti-oil rallies scheduled in 20 American cities. Police estimated the crowd at between 1,200 and 1,500. Mayor Ernest D. Angelo Jr., a pe-

troleum engineer, proclaimed Tuesday "Oil Appreciation Day" in Midland as the lunch-hour crowd interrupted five speeches with applause during the 35-minute rally.
