



NASSAU, Bahamas — A million, you can buy an estate 50 miles south of Nassau. Norman's Cay, whose man owner left rather swiftly in a police raid.
Its owner, a West Coast lionaire, left in a huff when police raided it.
It was listed for sale for a price tag of \$2,500,000, included a yacht club, private airport with a 3,000-foot runway and 1,000-foot concession, four incomplete limestone club house, 10 vacation manager's house, staff quarters, 15 people, a laundry, a maid shop building, a garage, a warehouse.
The government-linked Bahamas News Service said the 6 1/2-mile-long island was a favorite refueling and rest stop for boats and planes in the Bahama Islands.
Early this year, visitors complained of being ordered off the island by security guards who German-accented English. Those ordered to leave was a Solomon, a member of the Bahamian Parliament.
After two inconclusive police, officers showed up dawn on Sept. 14. They arrested the man, confiscated two rounds of ammunition of calibers, a pound of marijuana, small vial believed to be cocaine. Four Americans charged with possession of drugs.
A few days later, owner's order announced he was returning to Germany. The 100 contractors hired for his \$6 million improvement program were dismissed and his aides left Nassau. This week, it went up for sale.

Porn films said to raise aggression

MADISON, Wis. — Mad scientists who view violent graphic films seem to show an aggressive behavior against says a University of Wisconsin psychologist.
"The (violent) erotic material appear to have an effect on subject's willingness to aggress against women, his readiness to rape and his tendency to view as not being violent," Edward Donnerstein said in a news release.
Donnerstein said aggression become "very popular" in films. The common scenario, he said, showed the woman resisting and in a few minutes coming a willing participant. "What happens to her."
He used student volunteers, whom he "mildly angered" and posed them to four or five of film clips showing scenes of attacks.
The result "appeared to be aggressive effects on certain people," he said.
"Most people who watch aggression could leave and would happen," he said. "In certain populations, such as rapists, we should study more closely at precisely why these films and reading have."

Ex-shah finishes writing memoirs

CUERNAVACA, Mexico — Ousted shah of Iran has completed his memoirs, which he will publish on radio and possibly television, a spokesman for the ex-monarch Saturday.
Robert Armao, Shah Mohammad Reza Pahlavi's spokesman, said the memoirs will be published in French "within a couple months" by the Albin Michel publishing house of Paris.
The memoirs will be published in English shortly after his French publication. Armao said the shah would make radio and possibly television appearances to promote the work.
Armao said he was unable to close how much Reza Pahlavi be paid for the memoirs or the specific theme, other than including collections of the years of his Iran.
Reza Pahlavi began working his memoirs in French shortly he arrived in Mexico June 1978 and his wife and son have been living in Cuernavaca, an 80-mile community about 60 miles west of Mexico City.
Violent demonstrations ousted shah into exile in January 1979. He ascended the Iranian throne in 1941.
