TO BE ELIGIBLE TO ORDER THE TEXAS A&M SENIOR RING, AN UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT MUST HAVE AT LEAST NINETY-TWO (92) SEMESTER HOURS, WITH 30 HOURS AT A&M AND BE IN GOOD STANDING WITH THE UNIVERSITY. USING MID-SEMESTER GRADES TO FULFILL THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS, PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS:

## New coal pipeline gets House OK

WASHINGTON — The House Interior Committee voted Wednesday for legislation paving the way for construction of pipelines to carry Western coal to the East.

The bill was approved, 24-14, after the adoption of a key amendment intended to protect Western water rights from infringement by the federal government.

The amendment, a major victory for Western lawmakers, would prohibit the federal government from taking water for use by pipeline companies in violation of state laws.

The legislation would let the secretary of interior grant pipelines the needed right-of-way, including the power to build them across privately owned lands over the objections of the owners.

Before accepting the bill, the Westerners demanded guarantees that the states would have the final say on how much and under what conditions water could be used to carry the coal in the form of slurry, which is a mixture of raw materials with water.

The amendment was offered by Rep. Dan Marriott, R-Utah, after negotiations with members who had opposed two earlier efforts by Marriott to amend the bill.

The sticking point was whether and how a state's water laws could

be challenged by a pipeline, Marriott said. Under the amendment, a pipeline company would have to state its case to a "legitimate state public utility commission."

"In addition," he said, "a guarantee has been accepted in terms and conditions."

Before approving the committee also voted 20-12 to amend by Rep. John Dingell, D-Ohio, requiring the secretary to determine if pipeline would "constitute a disruption" of the coal and the receiving end before proving its construction.

Seiberling said he was the amendment because the Mine Workers had expressed concern over the possibility of a down of Eastern coal industry.

Moore, 47, is serving a sentence for firing several shots in San Francisco in 1975.


She was transferred to Lexington prison hospital from the high-security section of the Federal Correctional Institute Hospital.

Steve Pontosso, assistant warden at the FCI, said Tuesday, "She's still in satisfactory condition. She's only lost about 15 pounds since she's been here. She weighed 135 pounds when she got here and weighs 120 pounds Tuesday."

Moore began her hunger strike Aug. 10 at Alderson to protest more than six months' detention in San Francisco in 1975.

West Virginia authorities said she was transferred to the hospital because of her deteriorating condition.
