Non-candidate Gerald Ford was the only one of four national figures to beat President Jimmy Carter in a poll conducted by a Texas A&M University political science class.


Coming up short were Sen. Ted Kennedy, D-Mass., California Gov. Jerry Brown and former California Gov. Ronald Reagan. Missing from the list of possible presidential contenders were former Texas Gov. John Connally and Texan George

The students polled 200 households in the Bryan-College Station

Brown, Kennedy, Reagan and Ford were pitted against Carter. Ford fared better than the presi-

dent, 68 percent to 32 percent.

The ratings are better than expected for the president, but are difficult to compare with national results because of polling methods, Dr. James Dyer, assistant professor of political science said.


