**De Gaulle
widow, 79,
dies in Paris**

PARIS — Yvonne de Gaulle, widow of the late French President Charles de Gaulle, died early Thursday of a brief illness, members of her family said. She was 79.

The quiet, self-effacing first lady recently was hospitalized at Val de Grace military hospital, where what informed sources described as recurrent heart and blood circulation problems.

Mrs. de Gaulle's death occurred hours before the ninth anniversary of the death of her husband, who also at the age of 79 on Nov. 9, 1959.

Mrs. de Gaulle had lived in Paris since the death of her husband in World War II. She had lived in the United States for several months ago.

The fabulous De Gaulle family retreat, La Boisserie, at Colombes, Paris, was to be opened to the public for the first time because Mrs. de Gaulle no longer had the means to pay for the upkeep of the estate.

De Gaulle had refused to accept a pension as former president and died on the modest pension he received as a brigadier general.
