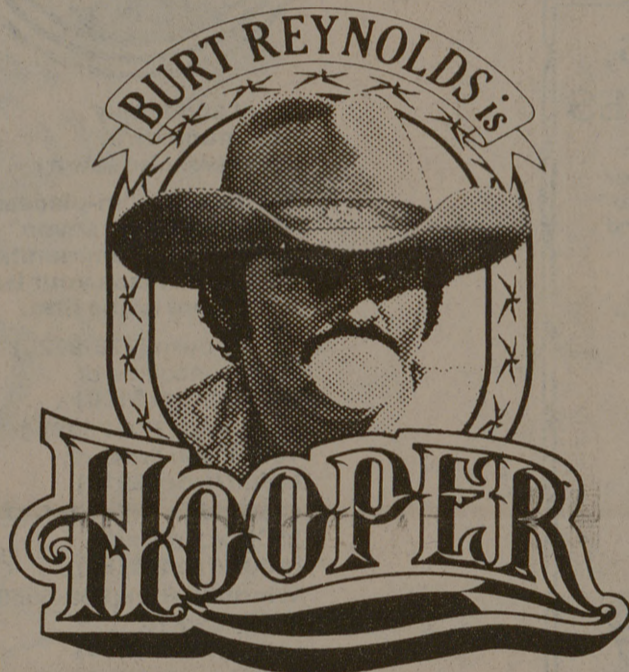

Giant theme parks set near Denver

AURORA, Colo. — Developers of a proposed amusement park east of this Denver suburb are thinking big. In fact, project officials say they are planning the largest theme park in the world.

Jerry Schafer, supervising producer for the project, said Tuesday construction on the 1,000-acre Science Fiction Land is expected to begin in about three years. The one cc include a 38-story ferris wheel, 1,000-lane bowling alley, H seat dinner theaters and 2,000 rooms.

The park also will be used for filming of a motion picture on the science fiction novel "Light," by Roger Zelazny, said.

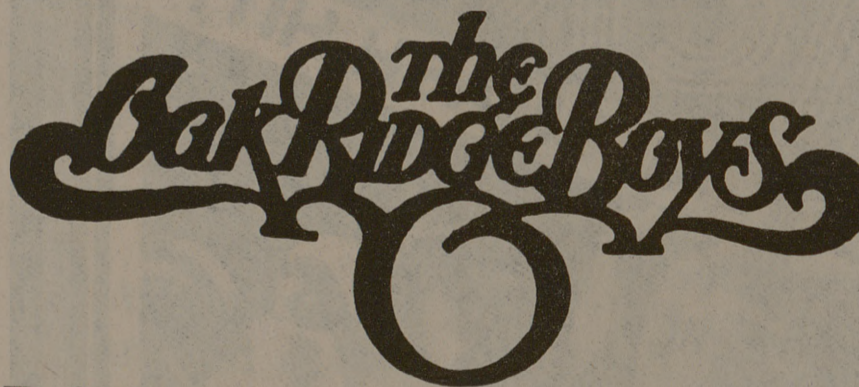
