Special bill to give Moody new name

State Sen. A. R. Schwartz, D-Galveston, said he will introduce a bill during the Legislature's special session calling for formal designation of Moody College as Texas A&M University at Galveston and having that institution share in the Permanent University Fund (PUF).

The senator announced his plans for sponsoring such legislation following his address Saturday at ceremonies marking the opening of a \$4.4 million classroom and laboratory building at the marine-oriented unit of the Texas A&M University System.

Renaming of A&M's Galveston unit and allowing for its inclusion in the PUF were among provisions of unsuccessful legislation sponsored by Schwartz during the past session for future funding of public higher education in Texas.

Schwartz said his special session bill will pertain only to Texas A&M activities, explaining that any PUF-related bill affecting the University of Texas System will have to be introduced by someone else. The Texas A&M and UT systems share the PUF.

The aspect of Schwartz's bill dealing with the name would settle a legal issue raised when the Texas A&M University System Board of Regents earlier this year designated the unit in Galveston as Texas A&M University at Galveston. A subsequent attorney general's opinion stated the regents did not have the authority to make the name change and that it could be made only through legislative action.

Schwartz said he supports the regents' action, noting the only legislative involvement in the name of the institution was a 1931 authorization to establish a "nautical school for boys."

Texas A&M's Galveston unit began in 1962 as the Texas A&M Academy. Various designations were used as the institution expanded.

If approved, Schwartz's bill would authorize expenditure of PUF at Galveston in the same manner that Texas A&M's portion of institutionally-guaranteed funds used for construction projects at other similar institutions within Texas A&M University System.

The Galveston senator supports the regents' previously expressed support to include the marine-oriented unit in PUF resources.

Texas A&M Regents Clyde Wells, who officially presented the new 29,000-sq-ft building to the Galveston unit, underscored that commending the regents' action.

"Quite some time ago, the endorsed legislation that brought this institution into the Permanent University Fund," Wells said, "We believe, as does Schwartz, that this will be a fine step."

"It is our intent to provide the finest marine-oriented institution be found anywhere," Wells added, "and such a goal can only be obtained with the continued support of the regents and the elected and appointed trustees of the Galveston Board of Visitors, the student advisory committee, Dr. John R. Schwartz, the institution's assistant vice president for academic affairs."
