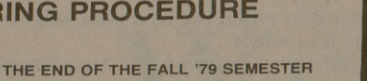

Rulings affect corporation justices of peace, truckers

AUSTIN — Attorney General Mark White has issued three separate rulings affecting truckers who haul agricultural products, corporations that issue bonds to finance commercial projects and justices of the peace who had insisted that arraignments be in the same courts that issue search warrants.

White said Monday the Railroad Commission has authority to set rates for truckers hauling agricultural products, despite new legislation relaxing requirements for trucking licenses.

"In our opinion, it is your duty to set rates to be charged by persons transporting property under the authority of a seasonal agricultural license," White told the state agency.

special industrial development corporations set up under the new law do not need approval of his office for the revenue bonds they issue.

In a third ruling, White said that a justice of the peace cannot require police to return suspected criminals to his court for arraignment, even though he issued the search warrant that led to an arrest.

The head of the State Commission on Judicial Conduct, Maurice S. Pipkin, asked the attorney general for a legal ruling to settle a controversy between justices of the peace and

district court judges in County.

Some peace justices arraignments — and assign public-paid attorneys for defendants — must be in the courts which issued a search warrant, particular case.

"When a justice of the peace as a magistrate, issues a warrant returnable to him, a plaintiff alleging an offense through the search need not appear with him," White ruled.

Governors favor regulating trucks

AUSTIN — Deregulation has not worked in the airline industry, and should not be tried in the nation's trucking industry, the Republican Governors Association said Tuesday.

The governors unanimously approved a resolution by Gov. James A. Rhodes of Ohio favoring continued regulation of the trucking industry.

Minutes later, the governors adopted a resolution calling for deregulation of oil and gas prices and criticizing bureaucratic regulatory barriers in that industry.

"Airline deregulation looks good on paper, but it is not working," Rhodes said. "Already service is being cut to many cities. Cargo and

passenger rates have jumped since deregulation.

"We can't afford to let that thing happen to the trucking industry, which American business consumers depend so much on."

The governors also approved solutions calling for a continuation of the federal revenue sharing program, and urging the American people to respond to appeals by public and private organizations in aid of the United States on behalf of suffering in refugee camps in East.

The resolution also urged activities in Phnom Penh to open a route from Thailand into Cambodia to allow supplies to move into the refugee camps.
