1. MID-SEMESTER ORDERS WILL BE TAKEN ONLY FROM OCT. 29TH UNTIL DEC. 7, 1979.

Biologist say oil spill effects are distorted

BOSTON — Environmentalists have intentionally distorted the effect offshore oil and natural gas drilling would have on life in the rich Georges Bank ground, an oil industry biologist Tuesday.

Oil is a "biodegradable part of the environment" and moves into the ocean from natural sources than would come from drilling, Keith G. Hay, conservation director of the American Petroleum Institute based in Washington.

"There has been an intentional distortion of the facts of oil products on a fishery resource," told reporters at a briefing in Boston sponsored by the API.

Hay and oil company representatives said domestic oil dependence is critical because of the nation's dependence on foreign sources.

The federal government will accept bids for exploration on 116 Georges Bank tracts—area of 660,000 acres. The Bank supplies the United States 14 percent of its yearly fish catch.

Environmentalists and lawyers of the states of Massachusetts and Maine are fighting the lease grounds the Department of the Interior did not adequately study the effect of oil spills on the fishery.

The case will be heard Monday the 1st U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals.

Hay said the oil companies committed to protecting the industry, but reports of operations harming fish are "conjecture and misconception," adding, "We love fish just as much as you do."

Spilled oil floats on top of the water, he said, and then disperses rapidly. It also picks up dirt and silt suspended in the water gets heavier and sinks to a level several feet below the surface.

Conservationists say a submergence oil slick would kill large numbers of fish eggs, which tend to float three feet below the surface.

But the slick thins out too quickly to harm adult fish, he said, and "tar balls" which form are inert they sink to the bottom or washed up on beaches where they are "cosmetically bad" but lack apparent effect.

Results of the 1969 Santa Barbara, Calif., oil spill and this year's Gulf of Mexico blowout show oil spill effects are temporary, Hay said. He said Britain's North Sea drilling shows oil platforms can exist in waters with fishing fleets.
