Iran's army
in disarray
AF chief says

SAN ANTONIO — The Chief of Staff said Thursday armed forces are in a "state of disarray," but declined comment on options available to the United States during the crisis.

Gen. Lew Allen Jr., chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, said Thursday that the military is observing special holy days and are in "a state of high tension."

"They (Iranians) are a people that are clearly excited," said Allen.

The military leader said that many armed citizens were being mobilized, but the military establishment has been disorganized since the late 1970s because of the power from deposed Shah Reza Pahlavi.

"There are a lot of people on the streets with guns, but the forces are in a substantial disarray," said Allen.

Allen repeated President Carter's pledge that the United States would not be committed to the safe return of the American embassy in Tehran.

"This is a situation that is unparalleled and distinct," Allen said, "disagreeing with those who compared the Iranian situation to the Cuban missile crisis. However, the U.S. security has been placed in danger because of the distance between the two countries."

Allen added that his support of SALT II agreement with the Soviet Union had not been shaken by the Russians' initial inflammatory casts into Iran.

"SALT II is not based on resolutions of difference between the United States and the Soviet Union," he said, "maintaining that the Soviets have been somewhat in the Iranian crisis."

Firm to test
Bay City dam's safety

HOUSTON — The construction company building a nuclear power plant 70 miles southwest of Houston has answered a worker's claim that a substandard dam work with a test of safety tests.

Brown & Root Inc. said it will test the 13-mile-long earth dam for a 7,000-acre cooling pond at the Bay City nuclear plant being built by Houston Lighting & Power Co.

"clear any doubts" about the dam's safety, a similar dam designed by Brown & Root, but built by another contractor, collapsed in Florida Oct. 31, 1978, more than 1,000 residents left their homes and causing \$10 million in damage.
