HARTFORD, Conn. — A former state prison psych says the prolonged captivity of American hostages in Ira

Dr. Dominic R. Marino, former director of mental h services at Somers state prison, said the 50 hostages at the Embassy in Tehran are probably under the same intense ure that caused Hearst to become sympathetic to the who abducted her five years ago.

He said the extent of psychological changes in the Amer hostages in Iran would depend on the severity of the condition under which they are being held.

"If they are being deprived of fundamental experien such as sight and movement — it will increase the psychol effect," Marino said. Even if there is no violence or bodily harm, the ex
