Court keeps adoption records secret

WASHINGTON—The Supreme Court Monday let stand a ruling barring adopted people from their sealed adoption records out a specific reason.  
The justices refused to hear appeals by the Alma Society, a group of adopted New York adults, because a federal appeals court refused to hear their appeals.  
The case arose in New York where statutes requiring the sealing of adoption records were challenged by 19 people who were adopted.  
They argued they should be able to see their records, which they said would help them without proving a legal right.  
Lack of access to such records, they contended, causes psychological trauma in some cases them or their children, and problems without knowing their history.  
It also creates fears of some problems with religious identity when the family's religion is known, they alleged. And they argued the law violated amendments to the Constitution.  
A federal district judge in the case.  
The 2nd U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals agreed, holding New York's sealed records statute "violated the privacy of the adoptees," including the "stigma of illegitimacy" adopted child's new life by his original birth certificate, issued with a new name under his name.  
More than 100,000 adoptions do not apply to adoption, the state still has "an interest in protecting the privacy of the adoptees," the court concluded in holding the laws.
