Iraqi claims oil price gap needs closing

United Press International BAGHDAD, Iraq — Iraqi Oil Minister Tayeh Abdel Kerim said Monday the Organization of Petroleum Exporting Countries should bridge the gap between the cartel's ceiling price and those prevailing on the world's spot markets.

A barrel of oil brings as high as \$40 on the spot market in Rotterdam compared with the OPEC ceiling of \$23.50 a barrel.

Abdel Kerim also spoke out against the cartel's two-tier pricing system and said OPEC's Monday meeting in Caracas should put an end to the speculative trading, the Iraqi news agency said. He blamed international oil companies for uncertainty in the oil markets and said a single pricing system could end such

Abdel Kerim made the remarks before leaving for Brazil on a Latin American tour. He will represent Iraq at the Caracas meeting.






