Each of them is a symbol of the largest sports phenomenon of the 1970's.

If the 1960's were the age of watching — with the building of the Astrodome touching off a boom in stadium construction and professional sports leagues expanding cross country the 1970's were the age of doing.

But for those who didn't want to take part, there was still plenty to watch in the 1970s.

And the thing that most people wanted to see was still football.

Inflation ate away at the dollar and gasoline prices wiped out vacations, but on Friday night in rural Texas, high school football was still king. Schools such as Brownwood, with coach Gordon Wood given a special dispensation by the city council to keep working past the retirement age, carrying on the tradition.

In the Southwest Conference the Baylor Bears — the ultimate underdog for so many years — finally won ton Cougars were admitted to the conference and promptly won or shared in three out of four champion-

And Earl Campbell became the all-time leading rusher in conference history, won the Heisman Trophy and at the end of the decade began

what promised to be a successful career with the Houston Oilers.

Campbell turned Houston into a Super Bowl contender overnight, drawing record crowds to the Astrodome and putting the Oilers into the playoffs for two consecutive years.

And in Dallas, despite changes in the roster, coach Tom Landry and

the Cowboys rolled on and on. At year's end they had made the playoffs for the 13th time in 14 years.

During the decade Dallas appeared in a record five Super Bowls and won two of them.
