Not signing oath threatens jobs in

DALLAS — Ten of the 128 faculty and staff members of Dallas Baptist College could lose their jobs because they did not sign "Articles of Faith" statement saying they consider the Bible accurate and believe in the non-evolutionary view of creation.

Employees of the college — from the president to janitors — were required to sign the seven-page "Articles of Faith" by last Tuesday. Their contracts will not be renewed in May, said Vice President Thomas J. Rector.

Some of those who did not sign the document have said they would discuss it with college President Marvin Watson. At least two employees said they would not sign.

The oath, similar to a statement adopted by the Southern Baptist Convention in 1963, was part of a move to make the 1,000-student college "more Bible-oriented than any school in the area," said Rector.

Two of the most disputed portions of the statement involve the inerrancy of the Bible and evolution, stating, "We affirm our belief that man was created by a direct act of God in His image, not from previously existing creatures."

The pledge requirement was adopted at a November meeting of the school's trustees, headed by Dr. W.A. Crisswell of the First Baptist Church.

Busing draws protest crowd

AUSTIN - Chanting "we won't go," approximately 500 protesters demonstrated outside the Austin Independent School District administration building where negotiations on school desegregation plans are in progress.

The protest came Tuesday at the predominantly white campus where parents and students who chant "Hell no, we won't go" urged school officials to call off the negotiations with attorneys for the U.S. Justice Department, Mexican American Legal Defense Fund and NAACP.

School trustees face a Saturday deadline for submitting a desegregation plan to U.S. District Judge Robert Taylor.

More than 2,000 students and parents attended a hearing Monday night on two alternative proposals the school district for busing to a 15,000 of Austin's 58,000 students to meet federal court desegregation decrees.

Spokesmen for the minority plaintiffs in the 9-year-old lawsuit said the school district plan does not go far enough.

Busing foes complained the school district plan threatened "massive peaceful civil disobedience."

Torres case prison terms start Dec. 28

HOUSTON — Three former policemen convicted of civil rights violations in the 1977 beating and drowning of Joe Campos Torres have been ordered to report to federal minimum security prison in Alabama Dec. 28.

Terry Wayne Denson, 31, Stephen Orlando, 24, and Joseph James Janish, 25, were assigned Tuesday to the prison at Maxwell Force Base in Montgomery, Ala., to serve their year-and-a-day sentences.

U.S. District Judge Ross Sterling, who originally imposed 10-year sentences suspended in lieu of five-year probation, resented them this year and a day after an appeals court said probation was illegal in a death case.

Torres, 23, drowned in Buffalo Bayou in May 1977 after arrest barroom complaint. Investigation disclosed he was taken to a parking lot overlooking the bayou, beaten and then either pushed or fell into the bayou.

The officers said Torres was also in the last time they saw him he was swimming across the bayou to what they expected to be freedom and death.

288 women apply for jobs as astronauts

HOUSTON — Nearly 3,000 people, one-tenth of them women, applied to become astronauts in the two-month recruiting period which ended Dec. 1, a Johnson Space Center spokesman said.

Terry White said Tuesday that 2,649 men and 288 women applied for pilot and mission specialist slots to be filled for the space shuttle program this summer.

As usual, there were many more applicants for mission specialist than pilot, which requires test pilot experience. White said there were 2,759 applications for specialist, 489 for pilot. Some 341 persons applied for both.

White said a JSC selection board was narrowing the applications "to those most qualified." He said approximately 100 applicants will be chosen for preliminary screening, physical examinations and interviews at JSC next spring.
