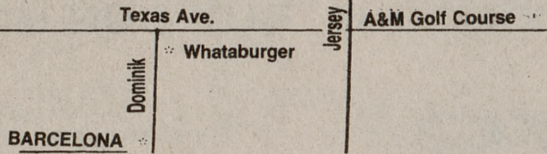

## Shuttle has testing problems; launch may be off until 1981

CAPE CANAVERAL, Fla. — Engineers and scientists are having more problems with the space shuttle Columbia.

A five-day test began Monday night, but trouble appeared before it started when a simulated engine failed to function. Space agency officials said if they couldn't get it going in time, the make-believe launch would be scrubbed.

The simulator was one of three installed to replace the three on-board rocket engines taken to Rockwell International's Rocketdyne Division plant at Canoga Park, Calif., for modification.

Backup astronauts Air Force Col. Joe Engle and Navy Cmdr. Richard Truly were scheduled to climb into the cockpit of the space shuttle Columbia for the mock-flight late Tuesday.

It was to be a repeat of a simulated space flight conducted Dec. 20 by the Columbia's primary crew of John Young and Navy Cmdr. John Crippen. They plan another make-believe launch Wednesday if all goes well.

In that test, the Columbia will be operated with electricity produced by on-board fuel cells instead of outside power.

The first space shuttle flight had been scheduled for last November, and is now set for June 30.

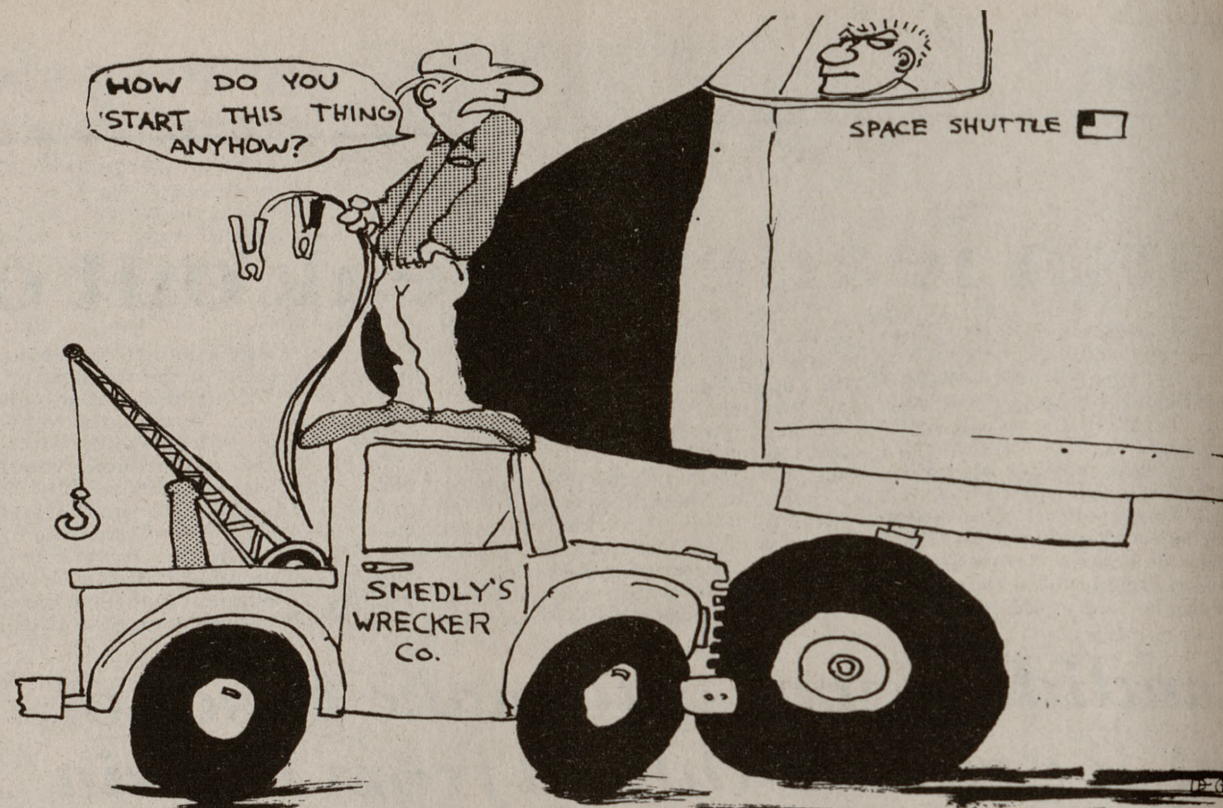

## Arab retracts attack story

BELLEVUE, Wash. — A Lebanese student who claimed three men mistook him for an Iranian and beat him unconscious has confessed he made up the story because he was ashamed to admit his brother had hit him, police said.

Camille el Hannah, 17, a student at Bellevue Community College, said it was his brother who hit him and gave him two black eyes, Police Capt. Dan Hansen said Monday.

El Hannah originally reported three men attacked him in the college parking lot Nov. 30, hit him over the head with a large tree branch and knocked him out.

Hansen said police became suspicious because the student waited three days before reporting the alleged attack.

Thomas O'Connell, the community college's president, said El Hannah agreed to publicly retract his story to undo some of the damage to relations between American and Mideastern students at the school.

Police said El Hannah would be charged in juvenile court with making a false crime report.
