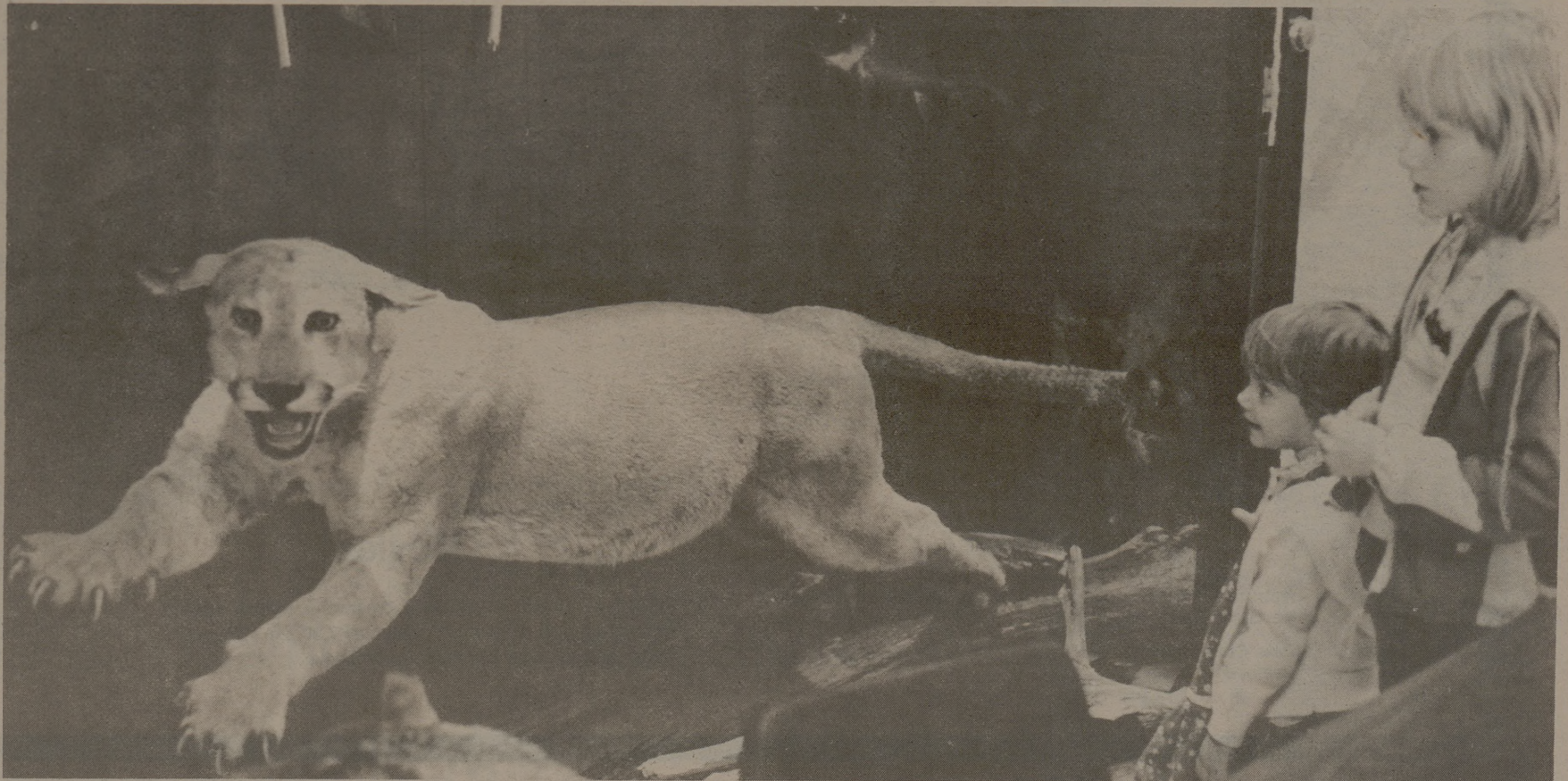
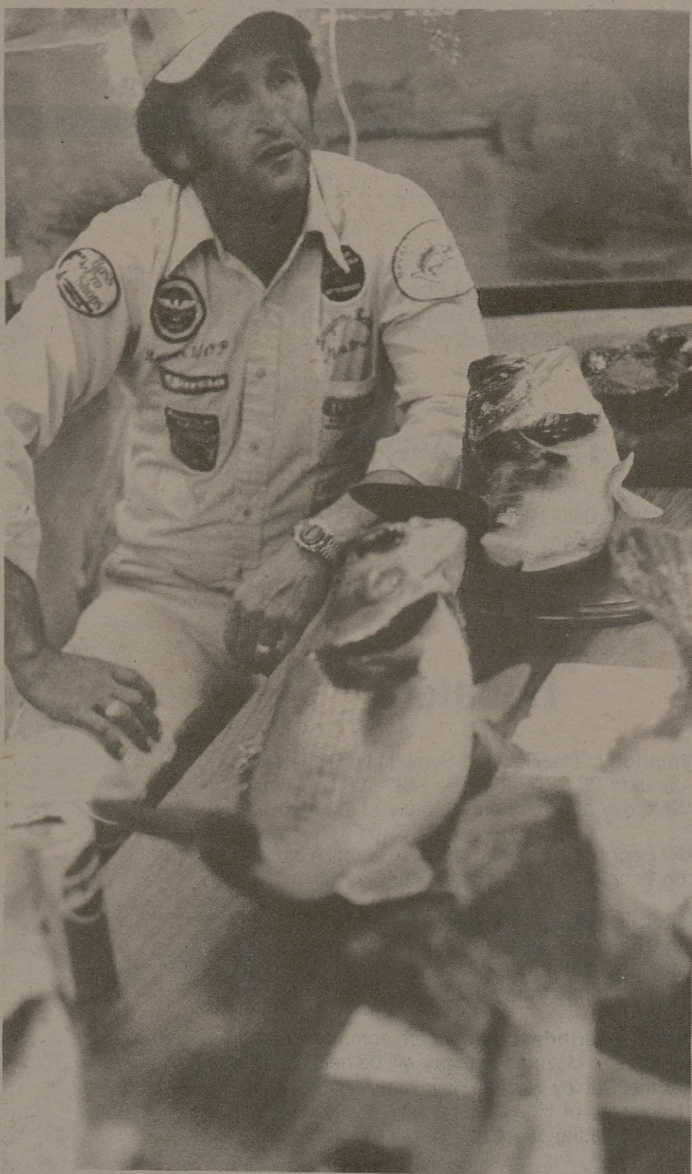


# Show bring Great Outdoors inside
