## Progress is key to staying in school

Students having academic problems should be given every chance to remain in school, but it is a disservice to them to keep them in school when they are not making progress, said the representative of several colleges at Texas A&M University.

"Frequently a college will do a student a disservice by letting him go on and on to get a degree in seven years that he should have gotten in four," said Lynn Zimmerman, assistant to dean in the College of Business Administration.

Diane W. Strommer, Liberal Arts Associate Dean agreed.

"If a student virtually flunks every course in the first semester, I won't give him the chance to do it again,' she said. "I keep him from making a huge hole he can never dig out of.

Strommer said that was the greatest service she could do for the student. She said that by staying out a semester, a student can decide if Texas A&M is the place he should


