System finds research funds

Faculty members at Texas A&M versity who are looking for rerch funding now have a quick and e method to obtain the informaon they need, said the associate e president of the Texas A&M Rech Foundation.

Heston Cherry said the Research dation, in cooperation with the fice of University Research and Office of Human Resources Rerch and Development, has made ilable to the Texas A&M faculty e Illinois Researcher Information

To me, this is one of the greatest ices I have seen anyone provide the form of readily availabel re-earch information," Cherry said. Cherry said the IRIS system, hich is located at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, offers Cherry said the system empha-quick, individually tailored search sizes post-doctoral and professional

containing suggested funding funding, and that only continuing sources and enough information for the individual to decide on the specific program he wants to pursue

The IRIS system is free to the faculty and the information is either accessible through a telephone hookup or through the mail, Cherry said.

The user of the system selects any number of subject keywords from over 800 subjects available in the keyword index. He then answers several questions that help limit the search to his particular needs. Once this is done the system matches these restrictions and keywords to produce a listing of applicable programs, he explained.

The listing contains the name of the agency, address, applicant criteria, deadlines for application and a short description of the

program.

programs are listed in the data bank. An advantage to the system is that

the information is updated daily to ensure that the information is cur-

Faculty members at Texas A&M can use the system at four locations. Telephone hook-ups are located at the Research Foundation, the Office of University Research, the Medical Sciences Library and at the Automated Information Retrieval Service in the library.

This is an experimental program for the first year to see how it works and how valuable it is to the Univer-
