**Emotional desire
subject of speech**

Citing companionship, closeness and intimacy as people's biggest emotional desires, Dick Purnell progressed into his speech by saying people want all the good things in life but don't know how to obtain them.

People stood along the wall, sat in the aisles, and crowded onto the stage behind him as he spoke on "Sex and Its Need for Intimacy" Thursday night in the Memorial Student Center.

The Christian speaker defined intimacy as a total life sharing. He said everyone desires it but hesitates because they fear pain.

"All of us have emotional scars where we've been hurt by someone of the opposite sex; therefore we are afraid of the very thing we want-intimacy," said Purnell.

"There is no such thing as painless love," he said. "The closer you are to a person emotionally the closer you are to pain. Love is not a feeling but a commitment and relationship that has its ups and downs."

Purnell said people are basically self-centered and want to be number one. He said that is the cause of relationship problems.

"We protect ourselves from pain by building a wall around ourselves for protection," he said. "The only problem is we keep people out and ourselves in and we become lonely."

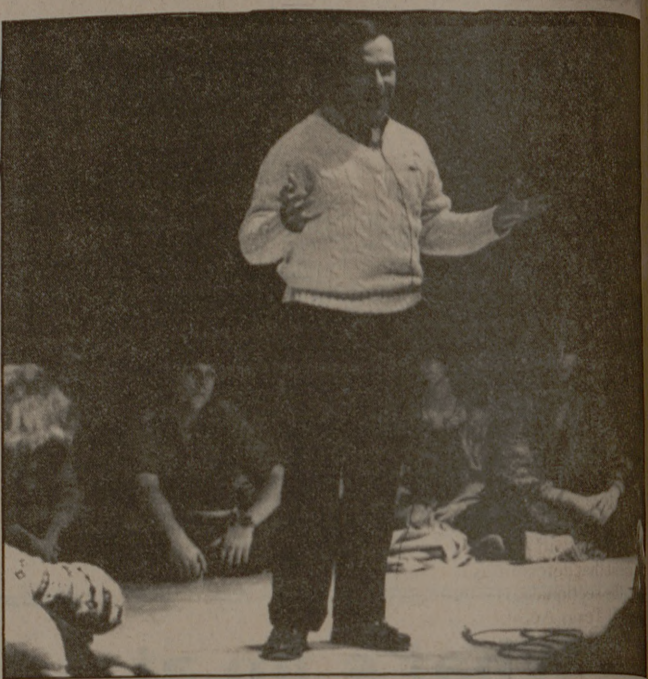
Purnell said Americans are also impatient. He said they desire everything today or tomorrow and look for shortcuts.

He said sex is the easiest and quickest shortcut to becoming intimate with a person. He said people enter into sex because they are looking for things to give them a thrilling feeling. He said the more one has sex the less thrilling and satisfying it is.

"Once you go all the way that is all there is and there is no more," said Purnell.

"Sex in a relationship is not the cement, it is the explosives. It destroys a relationship," said Purnell.

"We want so much to be close to somebody but don't want to wait to fulfill all areas of our lives," he said.

Purnell said people are made up of five types of characteristics: physical, emotional, social, mental, and spiritual.

He said when one characteristic is overemphasized the others cry out for fulfillment and dissatisfaction be-

gins to gnaw at a person.

"I believe in love and believe covers all five areas of a person," Purnell said.

Purnell was on a three-day speaking engagement and was sponsored by Campus Crusades for Christ.

Dean to talk to engineering students

The Student Engineering Council will hold a meeting for all engineering students, Thursday, at 7 p.m. in 102 Zachry Engineering Center.

Council president Chris Hinds, a senior electrical engineering major, said the meeting will give engineering students a chance to meet with the dean of the College of Engineering. Dean Robert Page will answer

questions about college policy, future plans and current problems.

The council's purpose is to ensure open communication between engineering students and the dean.

"We are the direct access for the 9,000 engineering students to the dean's office," Hinds said. The council is made up of the presidents of the major engineering societies, plus junior and senior representatives from each field.

The council's duties range from conducting polls to find out students' needs and reactions to changes, trying to get sandwich machines in the lounge in Zachry. The council also printing a magazine called *The Engineer*. The magazine informs engineering majors of search and development projects college is involved with.

"We want all the engineering students to come to the meeting so we can get some insight on what the SEC can do and how to use the council," Hinds said. "The council can be a very strong tool, if you know how to use it."
