United Press International LONDON — Gold dropped in value again Monday on European markets. The value of the dollar increased slightly on most.


Gold opened in Zurich at \$666 an ounce, down \$10 from Friday's close of \$676. In London it opened at \$675.50, down \$14.50 from Friday's

In Hong Kong, gold closed at \$\$8663.50 an ounce, down \$11.50 from \$1.6348; in Paris at 4.0910 French francs, up from 4.0860; in \$670 an ounce and stood at \$672.50 at the morning close, but dealers said prices eased with the lack of buying support at higher levels.

The dollar opened in Frankfurt at London where the pound sterling 1.7478 marks, up from 1.7450; in opened at \$2.2740.






