

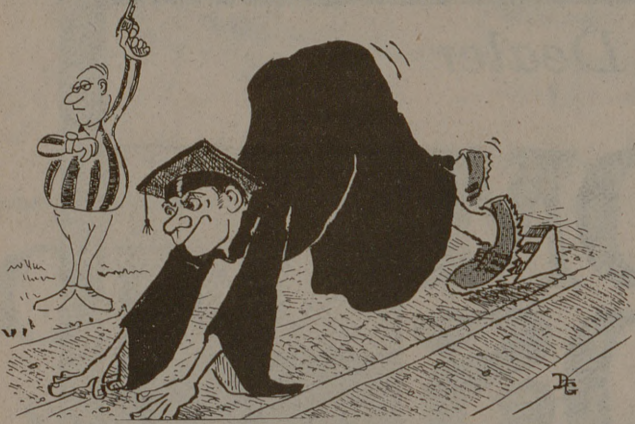

# World learns of credit card use

The businessman in Buenos Aires feels uncomfortable with the idea of credit cards but finds it difficult to travel without them.

The Israeli consumer uses plastic to cope with near-daily price increases in that country's inflation spiral.

The Greek tourist sees the credit card as a good deal because it can be used to take extra money along on trips out of the country.

Whatever the attraction, that unique American invention — the credit card — is undergoing a worldwide popularity surge, reflecting its greater availability and the closer attention inflation-battered consumers in many countries are paying to money management.

With three pieces of plastic outstanding for every American and few reservations about using them, the U.S. consumer is still the world's credit champion. There is no chance of the title passing to foreign hands.

But the overseas expansion of cards barely has begun to reach its potential, according to analysts who predict a snowball effect as each new card issued builds consumer familiarity and raises demand for plastic.

"It's the hour of the credit card," says Nestor Yoan, manager of the Argentine credit card company, Argencard. Local cards in circulation increased by about 25 percent to 200,000 last year but Yoan says, "There are a million and a half more families that could have a credit card now."

American credit card companies are pushing to capture shares of the foreign markets while local issuers have set up their own systems.

Building foreign networks has a double goal for U.S. issuers: tapping reservoirs of new customers as well as expanding outlets for Americans to use their cards overseas.

Foreign business was important enough for Visa to undergo a costly name change from BankAmericard to reduce translation problems with its cards overseas.

In no two countries is the credit card approached exactly alike. Attitudes toward personal debt are deep-rooted and vary by culture. National financial systems, of which

credit cards are a part, have evolved differently and local tax laws and economic conditions also shape plastic use.

In the United Kingdom, for example, 59 percent of workers still receive their pay in the form of cash compared with 5 percent in France and 1 percent in the United States. Barclays Bank says cash payments mean that many British workers don't use banks or their services — such as credit cards.

In Hong Kong, many card holders pay off all their accounts with the approach of the Chinese New Year. Chinese believe it is bad luck to enter the new year with outstanding debts.

Latest statistics from the American Bank cards, Visa and MasterCard Charge, show their use continues to expand although the rate is somewhat during the third quarter last year. This could signal the start of a pause in expanded spending plans by consumers who have reached record debt buildups.

In Europe, the growth patterns of cards still is geographically patchy. Credit living is a boom industry in Britain and Spain and catching on in France, Scandinavia and Greece. It has barely made a dent in the West Germany, Belgium or Yugoslavia.

As a result there are only an estimated 25 million cards in Western Europe and Yugoslavia — compared with a soaring 600 million pieces of plastic in the United States, including those issued by oil companies and retailers.

Despite the exceptions, credit card use never has been high. Foreign consumers are taking plastic plunge in droves, according to an international survey by

## Appliances will carry energy labels

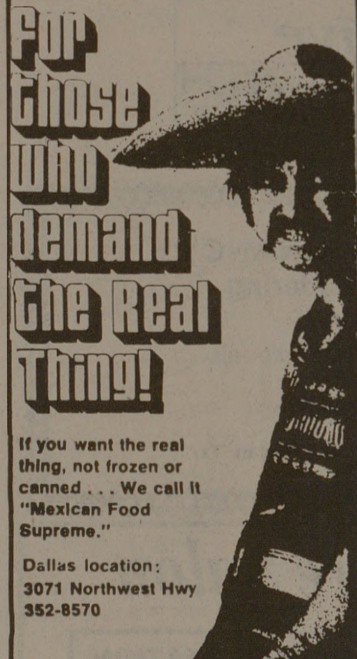

WASHINGTON — Within months, consumers will find yellow and black energy guide labels on seven types of household appliances.

A new federal rule requires labels to show energy-efficiency ratings of comparable appliances and estimates of annual operating costs.

The labels must appear on refrigerators, freezers, dishwasher-clothes washers and water heaters. Labels containing similar information must be displayed for room air conditioners.

The appliances covered in the labeling program account for more than 78 percent of all energy consumed in American homes — or an equivalent of 2.3 billion barrels of a year.
