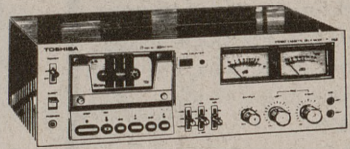
Dyer Gang Leader Reported Taking Personal Command

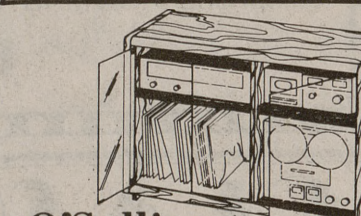
Only Name-Brand Stereo Up For Grabs

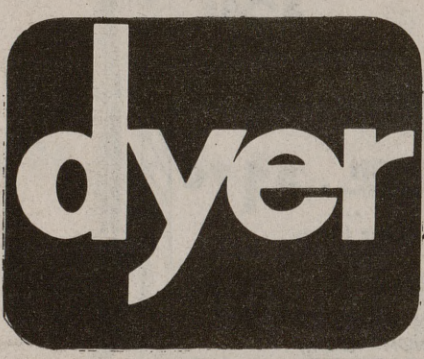

Texas A&M's basketball teams are awesome. The men's team is in the Southwest Conference and ranked 20th in the nation. The women are ranked third in the state. Aggie students are a dizzy, fickle bunch of ingrates.

I didn't say Aggie fans. The fans, all 4,904 of them, showed up for the night's game — the same as they have for all the other Aggie home games. Three weeks ago the Aggies beat the only other top team in the conference, Arkansas, before a packed house of over 8,000 and the over sole possession of first in the SWC. The crowds in G. Rollie Walker Coliseum have diminished ever since.

The first home game after the Razorback win was against the shooting Houston and only 6,000 people bothered to show support for the team. And now, 1,000 less than that.

If the reason for this was clear there would be no need for me or anyone else to say anything. The problem would simply be corrected. The problem is not plainly obvious. The ticket distribution plan has been the most consistent recipient of blame, but the students are blaming the athletic department for the policy. The Athletic Department does not make such policy.

Who does? The students, that's who. And guess who's doing the griping. Last night it would have been very difficult to put the blame on the ticket policy anyway. Anyone could have entered G. Rollie Walker Coliseum and found an excellent seat. No waiting in line and no waiting three hours of study time.

Associated Press writer Mark Schwartz remarked after last night's game, "I can remember when people would pack this place and be satisfied to leave with a moral victory." Now, the Ags are on their way to a SWC title and winning more than moral victories.

The Aggies may have lost their first SWC game on Monday night. They played their worst game of the season in doing so, but they are still game winners, the talent didn't pack its bags and leave and the basketball team does not have a history of choking. If anything, the basketball team has a history of winning the big ones.

So where are the people? Attendance at the Aggies' ten home games this season has been 4,950, that is 3,000 bodies below capacity. Included in that total is an exhibition game against Australia. Some people say that game shouldn't be considered because it was played before the season started. But, there were more people at that game than attended the other games, including last night's. In SWC play, the attendance at G. Rollie is approximately 5,650 per game.

So what, you say? Well, would you believe the Aggies have averaged crowds of 9,550 in their away games? Without the three games played in the basketball netherland of Alaska, the total jumps to 11,175 per game. Imagine people fighting to see the Aggies — everywhere. College Station. Even in the Southwest Conference the Aggies average 8,000 people on the road. That is G. Rollie's capacity. It is 300 more people per game than our boys have cheering for them at home.

Want some other opinions? Here are the thoughts of two guys who job it is to please Aggie basketball fans.

Jerry Arp is the new Assistant Athletic Director for Sports Promotions at A&M. He was hired out of Clemson to fill up G. Rollie Walker Coliseum. "It's awful," said Arp. "I can't understand why fans won't come out to see a team that's in first place in the Southwest Conference, and that's playing good basketball and a team that has a chance of getting to the final four. The thing they need is total support. Our ticket personnel sold all the tickets they could possibly sell — they've turned second purchasers away."

"I wish I knew what the answer was. If there's something wrong — somebody has any ideas how we can change then we'd like to hear them. Personally, I'm embarrassed for the yell leaders, the band and especially for the players. The crowd that was here tonight was good but the guys deserve better than that. If we can't get a better crowd to cheer then something's wrong."

David Walker and I were weaned on Aggie basketball — the championship years of Barry Davis and Sonny P. and the lean ones before and after. We have since gone somewhat separate ways. Walker is the Assistant Sports Information Director for basketball. I'm the Assistant Sports Information Director for basketball. I'm in charge of used to come over here for games — there were 17,000 students used to come to fill up the coliseum when you're 10-1 and leading the conference what does it take. These players have worked hard to get where they are and they're not getting support. We just haven't had the people turn out like they should. I'm upset about it. The players are upset about it. When it comes time to recruit the other schools will say "Look the Aggies were 10-1 and they only had 3,000 students at their games." Everybody associated with the team deserves a better deal than they're getting here at home."

If you are one of those who is ticked off at what I had to say, you're guilty, sucker. Please don't let it get so bad that someone has start using that annoyingly ridiculous word — two-percenter.
