Ladies play Mean Green Classic, meet TWU in opening round

The Texas A&M women's basketball team will participate in the Mean Green Classic in Denton this weekend. It is a four-team tournament with A&M, Arkansas, North Texas State (the host team) and Texas Women's University.

Texas A&M and TWU play in the first game at 6 p.m. Friday and then North Texas State and Arkansas play at 8 p.m. The winners of those two games will play Saturday in the championship game at 8 p.m., with the consolation game played at 6 p.m.

This is the second year of the Classic, which TWU won last year over North Texas State, 72-70.

The Aggies are now 15-8 on the year and winners of nine out of their last 10 ball games, including Wednesday night's 63-56 victory over SMU.

Arkansas comes into the tournament with an overall record of 14-3. Second-year coach Joan Henn's team is led by Lita Sticklin, a 5-9 forward averaging 18.3 points and 6.9 rebounds a game. Tammy Siefkles is also averaging in double-figures with 11.9 points a game. The Lady Razorbacks have done well on the road, where they have won seven of eight games.

TWU brings a 16-7 record to the Classic. The Pioneers, under head coach Bob Schneider, are on a five-game winning streak and are led by freshman Bridget Phillips who is averaging 14.8 points a game and 9.1 rebounds.

NTSU takes a 3-18 record into the tournament. First-year coach Denise Smith has two talented players in J'Lynn Johnston, who is averaging 14.9 points a game, and Beverly Sampey, who leads the team in rebounding with an average of 11
