Woman on death row: state one of only seven in U.S.

United Press International MILLEDGEVILLE, Ga. — Each morning when she awakes, Rebecca Machetti looks at the green cinder-block walls and realizes that what she had hoped was a nightmare is real.

"Somewhere in Atlanta there is a death warrant that could be signed on me at any time and I could die," she said in an interview with UPI. Rebecca Machetti is one of seven women in the United States under sentence of death for murder.

All were convicted of killings that involved either a husband or a lover as victim or accomplice. All are in the South. All are living in cells that had to be adapted for the status of an unusual tenant. Although there are only seven women facing execution throughout the nation, there are about 6,600 men on death row.

Unlike the other six, however, the 41-year-old Machetti has exhausted her appeals in the state judicial system and has taken her case to the federal courts. The others are still in state courts.

Three women in Georgia are now sentenced to die, and there is one each in North Carolina, Alabama, Florida and Texas — five states in what the American Civil Liberties Union calls the "Death Belt."

Since 1930, there have been about 3,860 legal executions and only 32 were women. Machetti could be the first woman in 35 years to be electrocuted in Georgia.

Machetti was convicted along with her husband, Charles, who is also condemned, in the 1974 slayings of her former husband, Ronald Akins, and his wife. An accomplice, John Moore, was also convicted, but he was sentenced to life in exchange for his testimony.

According to court records, Machetti and Moore drove to Macon, Ga., from Miami, lured Akins and his wife to a subdivision and gunned them down for \$20,000 insurance. Although Machetti was in Miami at the time of the killing, she was convicted of conspiracy, punishable by death under Georgia law.

Once a nurse, Machetti now spends almost 24 hours a day in a corner cell in the clinic at the Women's Correctional Institution at Milledgeville. For the past three years, her daily routine begins at 6 a.m. She reads, watches television and talks "with my Lord."

Receiving and answering mail is a most cherished part of her day. Although she has pen pals in 137 countries, she feels her correspondence with others condemned to die is most important. She says writing inmates on death rows in other states

"gives me something productive. Cause mail becomes a thing."
She says she doesn't have visitors "because friends that have are in distant countries, distant states." Machetti's parents had to limit the number of visits because they are unable to pay for the Macon to Milledgeville and both been ill.

"But when they come, time for them to leave, I hate it."
During the interview, she seemed to be on an emotional roller coaster. For a time she was witty, charming and articulate, suddenly she would have back tears.

She jokingly asked her attorney if her business was because she had noticed the "same red coat for the years."
Minutes later, Machetti cracked, her lower lip quivered, her hands shook when she lit a cigarette.

"I may come across to you who is not at all troubled. I wonder sometime if they succeed in trying to kill me. I have to discard it because times it gets so bad I can't breathe."
Machetti, who declined to out her crime and anyone who says she has changed since she walked into the prison.

"I get the feeling that my little bit bigger. It has a capacity — a greater depth — her 'prison ministry' with all those she now faces. She has a story to tell."
"I am socially conscious, a good intelligence and I am able to articulate feelings," she said when she should be allowed in society. "This should mean something."

Her only prison contact is members of the staff. Machetti says she is a woman on death row. "But her conviction for conspiracy to murder, she calls it 'woman convicted on a knife even though it was proven was 'not only in another 700 or 800 miles away from scene."
"I think I have a lot to justify," she said. "I'm not afraid, just don't think I should be here."
