About 50 people were assaulted by Mark Medoff's play, "When You Comin' Back, Red Ryder?" in its opening night in the Rudder Forum Thursday.

They were assaulted by noise and a high level of tension. They looked shaken as they left the theater.

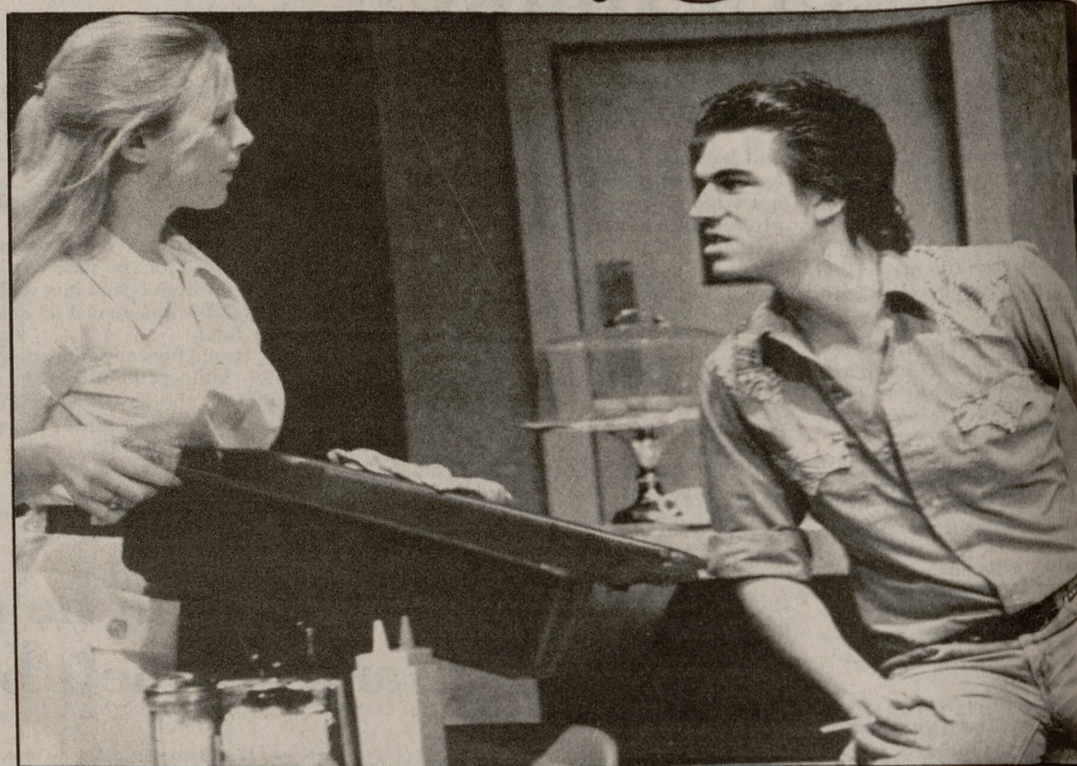

Dallas examiner denies try to exhume Oswald

DALLAS — The Dallas County medical examiner Thursday rejected a request to exhume Lee Harvey Oswald's body, which a British author contends is that of a Soviet agent impostor.

Dr. Charles S. Petty, chief medical examiner for Dallas County, said the exhumation would not be in the

"public interest" and he would not order one at public expense.

Oswald, who was killed two days after he allegedly assassinated President John F. Kennedy in Dallas in 1963, is buried in Rose Hill Cemetery in Fort Worth.

However, British author Michael Eddowes contends the body that is buried there is really that of a Soviet

agent who resembled Oswald from Eddowes requested the exhumation.

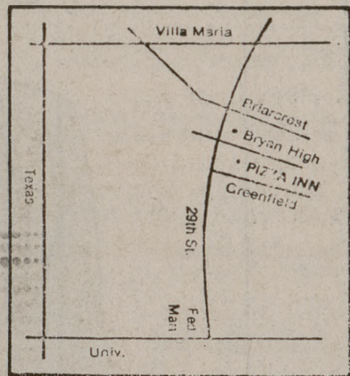

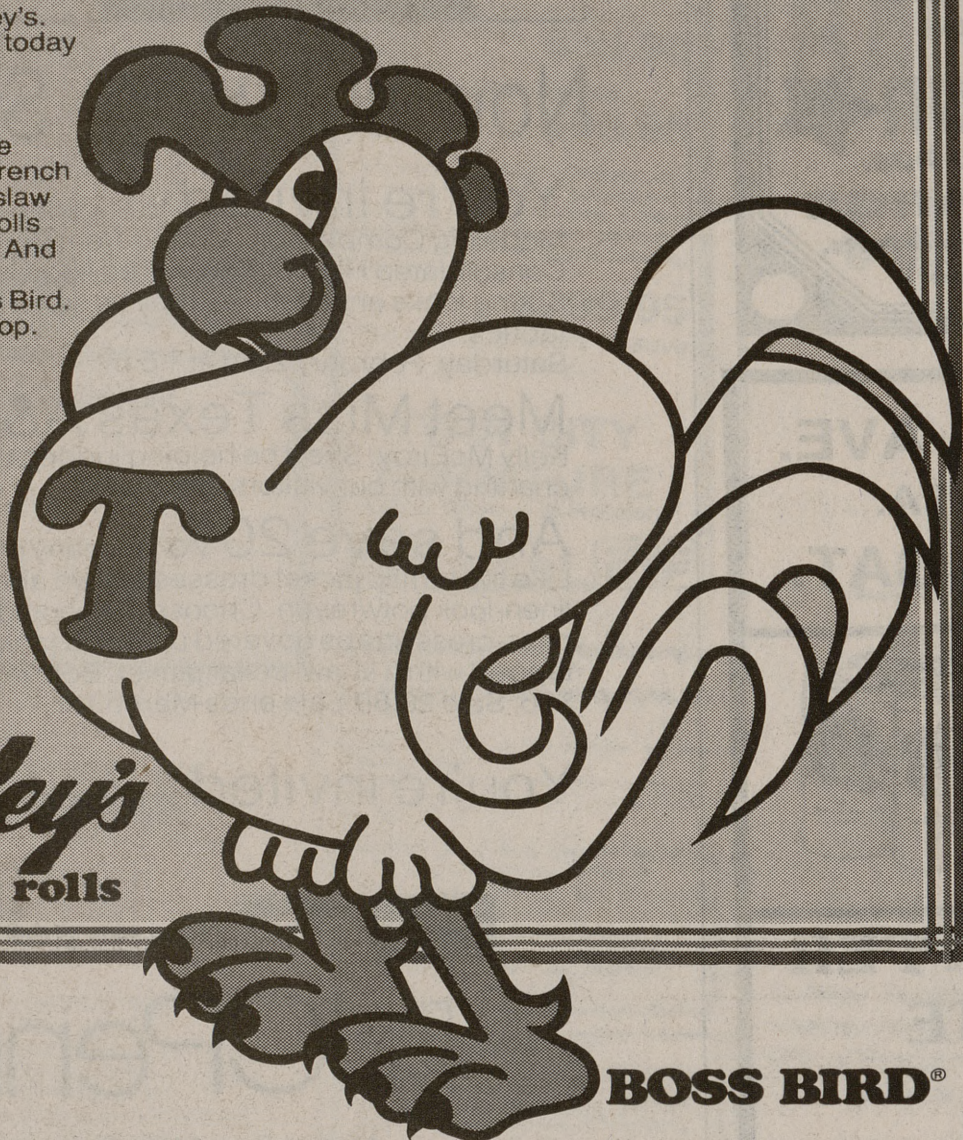
