McCall announced any Baylor student agreeing to pose nude would be subject to disciplinary action. McCall's decision aroused the criticism of several editors of Baylor's student newspaper, The Baylor Lariat. The editors were subsequently fired, which in turn caused the resignation of most of the Lariat staff and two journalism faculty members. Due to the telephone threat, Chan has been conducting all interviews

under armed guard.

Chan said the threat was an isolated incident, and he has found support.

'There is a guy here (from Baylor) right now with me who is training to be a minister," said Chan. "He takes you for what you are and doesn't condemn anyone. He doesn't condemn anyone as sinners or anything. He's a

Federal jury hears Clayton

United Press International HOUSTON — House Speaker Bill Clayton, ignoring his lawyers' advice to restrict his answers, Monday went before a federal grand jury to explain "what he said" and "what he meant" in tapes of three conversations with an FBI informant and a union boss who gave him \$5,000.
