Union is refusing to discuss with the United States measures it must take o comply with the terms of the untified SALT II arms limitation treaercent degreety, diplomatic sources said

Soviet representatives made clear scow has no desire to discuss retions required by the Strategic ms Limitation Treaty at this point hen the U.S. Senate still has not ken up the pact, the sources said. President Carter asked the Senate lelay consideration of the treaty, which requires a two-thirds vote for nate approval, in the aftermath of ne Soviet invasion of Afghanistan. 
To meet that deadline, U.S. specialists say, the Russians probably should begin work immediately since dismantling could take as long as 12 months.

The State Department had no immediate comment on the Soviet re-fusal to address SALT II compliance issues. However, sources said the United States is not overly concerned at this point.

Some U.S. officials voiced the opinion it would be unlikely for the Russians to discuss SALT II until the treaty is ratified — particularly not in the poor atmosphere following the Soviet invasion of Afghanistan.


