

A Texas A&M University student is circulating petitions on campus to try to show that not all female students think sex discrimination exists

The petition was drawn up in response to a suit filed against the University by Melanie Zentgraf, a senior female cadet who is suing Texas A&M for sex discrimination within the Corps of Cadets. The petition, written by Mollie White, a junior elementary educa-

tion major, states the women of Texas A&M object to the use of the phrase, "as representing the women at Texas A&M University," being used when referring to Zentgraf's status as class representative in her law suit. The petition then requests that in the future the phrase not be used in
