## Handicap problems viewed

Taking the handicap out of disability was the objective as administrators and handicapped students met on Mobility Awareness Day.

The administrators moved about the Memorial Student Center Monday in wheelchairs to briefly experience some of the problems facing handicapped students. They then met with the students and others in a meeting sponsored by Students

Concerned for the Handicapped. Gary Gray, on the organization's officers, presented a slide show about the problems facing handicapped students at Texas A&M University.

Some of the problems Gray mentioned were lack of curb cuts and poor quality of some existing curb cuts, problems with disabled parking zones, accessibility of certain buildings and accessibility to Kyle Field.

Steve Currier, coordinator of Services for Handicapped Students at the University of Texas, was the featured speaker.

He gave a slide presentation about the University of Texas' program, and presented ways to deal with problems encountered by handicapped students.

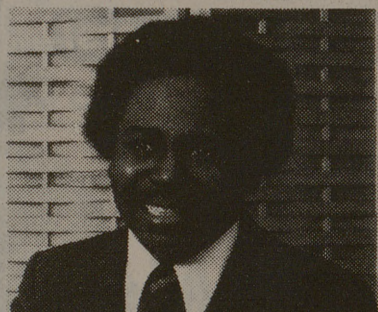
