Glaucoma drug tested at A&M

Laboratory tests of a new drug for treating glaucoma, which affects at least a million Americans, begun at Texas A&M University's College of Medicine.

The drug DMB may be even more effective and have fewer side-effects than other drugs currently on the market, explained Dr. George Chiou, head of medical pharmacology at Texas A&M.

With an \$80,300 grant from California research group of the Chiou Labs Inc., Chiou, head of the pharmacology at Texas A&M, is testing the new compound, said to be a purer form of an old glaucoma drug called DMC, being tested on human volunteers at Louisiana State University as a joint LSU-Texas A&M project.

The tests here will try to determine if DMB can successfully reduce glaucoma without the side-effects present in its cousin DMC (methylated carbachol). A new effect involves stimulation of subsequent depression of the optic nerves.

"We don't know yet if the DMB will be better," said Chiou, "But we feel DMC is so effective in its treatment of glaucoma with little or no side effects that improvement will be that more effective."

In the Texas A&M-LSU preliminary results by Chiou and Dr. Thom Zimmerman showed that reduces or eliminates side-effects such as eye irritation and pupillary constriction normally suffered by treatment of glaucoma with widely used drug pilocarpine.

Chiou said the encouraging results from the Louisiana study indicated those in earlier tests of glaucoma patients in Taiwan.

While glaucoma - a buildup of pressure in the eye - is primarily a disease of persons over age 40, Chiou said it can develop in the young as age 20.

Untreated, the pressure can damage the optic nerve and cause blindness.

About 178,000 new cases of glaucoma are reported in the United States each year and the number already blinded at least 200,000 more, despite the fact that regular eye checkups and a medical test can detect it in stages.
