Price controls may fit wages

WASHINGTON — A presidential advisory committee Wednesday recommended the administration relax its voluntary anti-inflation guidelines for prices to fit recently increased wage guidelines.

If approved by Carter, the new guidelines would allow companies to raise prices at an annual rate of 7.5 percent during the six-month period from April through September, instead of the currently allowed 6.75 percent.

The recommendation was made by a six-member Price Advisory

Committee appointed by President Carter in December.

R. Robert Russell, chairman of the Council on Wage and Price Stability, which administers the voluntary guidelines, said the administration would study the proposal and reach a decision as rapidly as possible.

Albert T. Sommers, chairman of the advisory panel and chief economist of a New York-based economic research organization, said relaxing the price guideline would make it more realistic and encourage compliance.

The administration already has adopted liberalized wage guidelines — calling for pay increases in a range of 7.5 to 9.5 percent this year — which were proposed by a wage advisory committee.

Sommers said allowing some-

what larger price increases under the voluntary program would bring that part of the program closer in line with the new wage guidelines.

In a February report, the advisory panel said credibility of the price guidelines program had been so se-

riously impaired as to "impe-

terioration of the voluntary compliance on which it rests."
The higher price guidelines would apply to the second half of the program's second year — which starts April 1.

Carter order to allow rise of \$20 per barrel in oil price

WASHINGTON — President Carter Wednesday signed an executive order lifting controls from the remaining 20 percent of oil from marginal wells — a move that will allow prices to rise by at least \$20 a barrel.

The Carter order is retroactive to April 1, the day before he signed the windfall tax bill covering decontrolled domestic oil profits.
Last Dec. 22, Carter announced he would postpone further decontrol of oil from marginal wells until a

satisfactory windfall bill reached desk.

At that time, 80 percent of original oil, or 450,000 barrels had already been decontrolled, almost seven months. The remaining 100,000 barrels a day was to be controlled on this past Jan. 1.

A huge amount of revenue involved in the Carter decision caused uncontrolled marginal oil to sell for only \$6.30 a barrel a month while the average crude oil price is \$29.50.

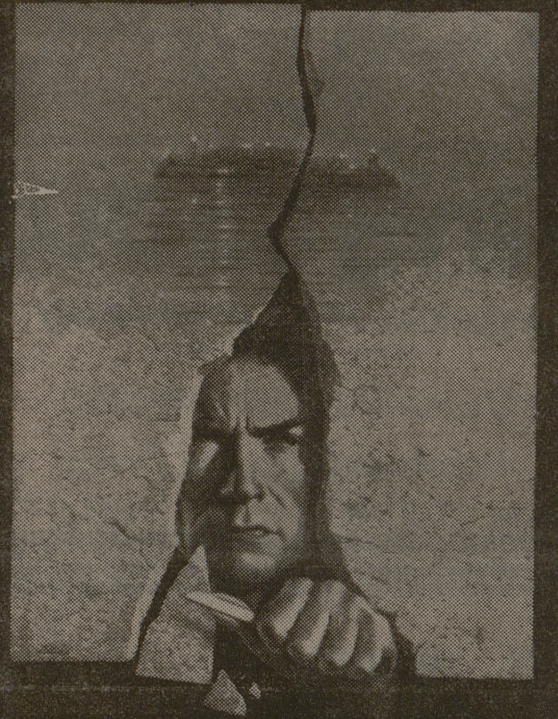

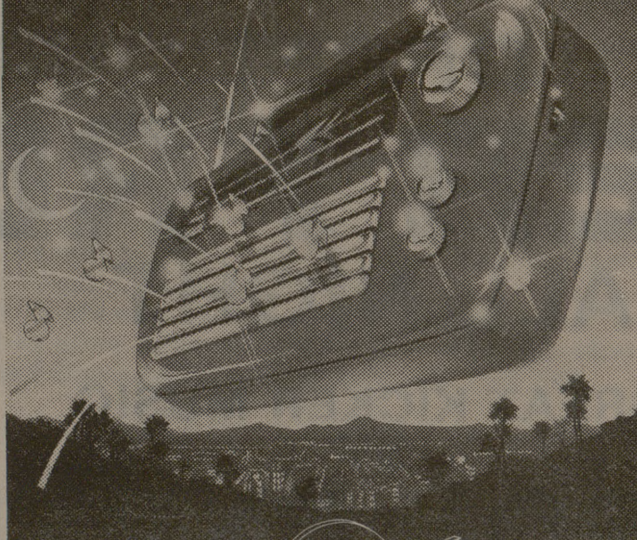
