Assistant coach Ted Nelson said Thursday the only athlete who won't be able to compete in the meet will be javelin thrower Mike Newsom, who has a sore arm.

Texas A&M faces some of the top track schools in the region — the University of Texas, Baylor, Lamar and the University of Texas-Arlington.

"Of course, University of Texas is real strong in the field events," Nelson said. Texas has been the Aggies' strongest opponent this spring and has the top marks in the Southwest Conference this season in four field events — the high jump and the triple jump, the discus and the javelin.
