EPA to eliminate benzene

United Press International WASHINGTON — The Environ-mental Protection Agency said Mon-day it wants to virtually eliminate the amount of cancer-causing benzene being spewed from eight plants across the country near which 10 million Americans live.

The plants produce maleic anhydride, a chemical used in the plastics, pesticides and lubricating industries, among others.
