Named in nine counts of fraud and one count of conspira commit mail fraud were Co sioner Bob Eckels and repor McIlvain of KHOU-TV. Bon each was set at \$5,000.

The indictment said Eckels McIlvain solicited money to fine the 27-minute film from corpo and individuals who were to donations were tax deductib The indictment said the Re

Educational Service Center, a funded agency which provide vices to local school district ceived \$47,680 in donations, which was transferred to the de dants. But the indictment sa total raised for the project \$55,980.25.

The indictment charged Ed and McIlvain fraudulently prom that the money donated was for viding copies of the film for Re IV; that the pair provided copi Region IV; and that the cont tions were tax deductible. dictment said actual production of the film were \$9,230.64.


