Newsman
official are
indicted

HOUSTON — A federal grand jury Monday indicted a television reporter and a Harris County commissioner on charges of mail fraud conspiracy in soliciting funds for production of a film about how tax venue is spent.
Named in nine counts of fraud and one count of conspiracy commit mail fraud were Commissioner Bob Eckels and reporter McIlvain of KHOU-TV. Both each was set at \$5,000.
The indictment said Eckels and McIlvain solicited money to finance the 27-minute film from corporations and individuals who were told the donations were tax deductible.
The indictment said the Regional Educational Service Center, a state-funded agency which provides services to local school districts, received \$47,680 in donations, which was transferred to the defendants. But the indictment said total raised for the project was \$55,980.25.
The indictment charged Eckels and McIlvain fraudulently provided copies of the film for Region IV; that the pair provided copies of the film for Region IV; and that the contributions were tax deductible. The indictment said actual production of the film were \$9,230.64.

AUSTIN — Funds for programs deal with alcoholics are running at a time when taxes on mixed drinks are raising more and more millions of dollars each year, Ross Newby, executive director of the Texas Commission on Alcoholism, Monday.
Newby called it a "supreme irony" for taxes on mixed drinks to contribute millions to the state government when funds for alcoholism programs in the state are dwindling.
State Comptroller Bob Bullock earlier Monday reported gross receipts on mixed drinks raised only one-quarter of a billion dollars during the first three months of the year.
"If Texas has already contributed nearly a quarter of a billion dollars worth of alcohol this year, we assume there are also costly problems related to this contribution," Newby said.
Newby said the Texas Commission on Alcoholism is allocated \$1.1 million by the state for 1980 compared to the \$22.1 million the comptroller reported raised in three months' levies on mixed drinks.
That's nearly 20 times as much as the Texas Alcoholism Commission receives from the state a whole year," Newby said.


