Six Aggies win prizes in math contest

Six Texas A&M University freshmen and sophomores won prizes in the annual undergraduate mathematics contest at the University.

First place winners were sophomore Joseph Gregg of Lubbock, physics major, and Joe Dellinger, sophomore geophysics major from Duncanville.

Second place awards went to sophomore Guy Sandel, a mechanical engineering student from Bryan, and Gregg Lesartre, a freshman mechanical engineering major from Houston.

Third place prizes were awarded to An Thanh Le, a sophomore electrical engineering major from the College Station; freshman math student Kathy Leonard of Euless; and freshman Carl Bargainer, an Abilene physics major.

First place winners received \$100 while second place prizes were \$50 and third place prizes were \$25. Prize money was provided from the Robert F. Smith Memorial Fund and Hillel Halperin Mathematics Fund.

The annual competition consists of around quickest solutions to a number of complex math problems.

Bolton prize presented to A&M senior

Texas A&M University student James E. Harris of Corpus Christi has received the Frank C. Bolton award in electrical engineering.

The Bolton award is given annually to a senior whose leadership, scholarship and service are considered worthy of recognition.

Harris received an engineering watch and chain and \$100. He will be added to a department listing previous recipients.

The selection is made by the Electrical Engineering Department faculty.

Harris transferred to Texas A&M from Del Mar College in Corpus Christi, and has maintained a 4.0 grade point ratio in the university's 4.0 system.

Harris is a member of the Great Singers, the Institute of Electrical and Electronic Engineers, Eta Kappa Nu and the Wesley Foundation.

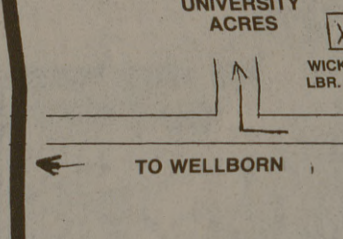
