
# Britton is off for the pros as Dallas drafts him third

David Britton, the man who stole basketballs as well as the hearts of Texas A&M University fans during his career here, graduated to the big leagues Tuesday, as he was drafted by the Dallas Mavericks of the National Basketball Association in the

third round of the college draft. Britton, a 6-4 guard who was instrumental in the Aggie's march to the SWC championship this season and subsequent victories against Bradley and North Carolina in the NCAA regionals, averaged over 11½ points a game during the season, and had a 45 percent field goal percen-

Mavericks General Manager Norm Sonju said Tuesday the fact that Dallas fans were familiar with Britton was a factor in his being picked by the NBA's newest expansion team, but his abilities outweighed everything else.

Aggie coach Shelby Metcalf

"I think he's a good player," he said. "He makes the big plays and he has a certain flair. Our fans certainly liked him.

Britton is known most for his showmanship, but Metcalf said Britton will probably settle down in the professional ranks.

"I'm sure he'll play it straight in the pros," he said. "It's an older age group. It'll be a good experience for

Metcalf said he feels Britton has the tools to make it.

"He's good one-on-one," he said. "He's a big guard. There aren't too many big guards around. He's a great rebounder, and a good scorer. I think he's got a good chance to make it. In fact, I'll be surprised if he

Metcalf said the fact that Britton will be close to his college home won't be too important.

"During the year, David played well anywhere. He played probably one of his best games of the year in Las Vegas. Being from New York and everything, he's played in front of all kinds of crowds. I don't think that'll

Britton was the second SWC player to be picked in the NBA draft. The Los Angeles Lakers picked Texas' Ron Baxter after Britton was chosen in the fourth round. SMU's Brad Branson was chosen by the Detroit

Texas A&M won the regular season SWC title this season, and also won the post-season tournament. In the NCAA regionals, the team defeated Bradley and North Carolina before losing to eventual national champion Louisville in overtime.


