In a United Press International survey of Republican state chair-men and other Republican National Committee members, Bush got 58 votes, Baker of Tennessee 22, and Rep. Jack Kemp of New York 17.

A total 116 of the 162 members of the RNC responded to the survey. A few picked two favorites, in which case both votes were counted. Eight declined to express a preference.
