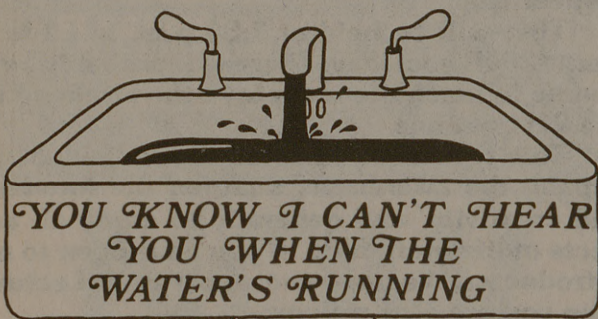

Astros lose to L.A., 3-0, but still 2 games in first

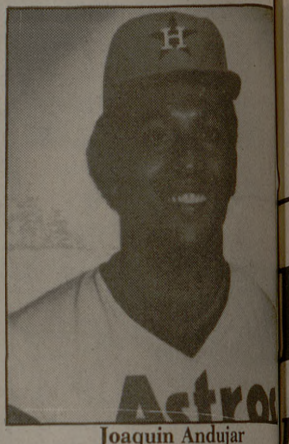

HOUSTON — Rick Sutcliffe pitched a three-hitter — to earn only his second win of the season — and contributed a two-run single Monday night to help the Los Angeles Dodgers to a 3-0 victory over the Houston Astros in the opener of a three-game series between the National League West leaders.

For Sutcliffe, last year's NL Rookie of the Year with a 17-10 record, the start was the first since he was demoted to the bullpen May 10, and it came as a result of an injury to Don Sutton.

Joe Morgan's two-out triple in the first inning, Cesar Cedeño's leadoff double in the fifth and Morgan's two-out

blooper single in the ninth were the Astros' only hits. Sutcliffe, 2-4, struck out two, walked two and lowered his earned run average from 7.04 to 5.88.

Steve Garvey's bouncing single over the head of third baseman Enos Cabell to open the fifth inning was the first Dodger hit off starter and loser Joaquin Andujar, 0-3. One out later, Ron Cey walked and Bill Russell doubled to drive in Garvey with the first run. Steve Yeager walked to load the bases and Sutcliffe bounced his two-run single up the middle.

The victory moved the Dodgers to within two games of the Astros in the NL West.

Despite late start, top seeds dominate Wimbledon's play

Despite a two-and-one-half hour rain delay, the prestigious Wimbledon Tennis Championships got underway Monday. Top-seeded Bjorn Borg easily swept first round challenger Ismael El Shafei of Egypt and second-seeded John McEnroe defeated fellow American Butch

Waltz in straight sets.

McEnroe, promising to put on display a different image from the one that earned him the label of "Superbrat," made a most impressive start on a cold, windy and wet day at Wimbledon when he kept his mouth muzzled and routed fellow American Butch Waltz, 6-3, 6-3, 6-0.

Two matches were discontinued because of darkness. Stan Smith was beating Adriano Panatta, 5-7, 6-3, 6-3, and Wimbledon's Mark Edmondson was even, 5-7, 6-4, 3-6, 7-6 when matches were postponed.

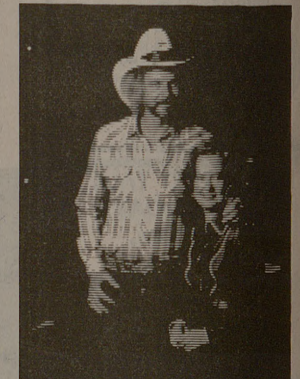
