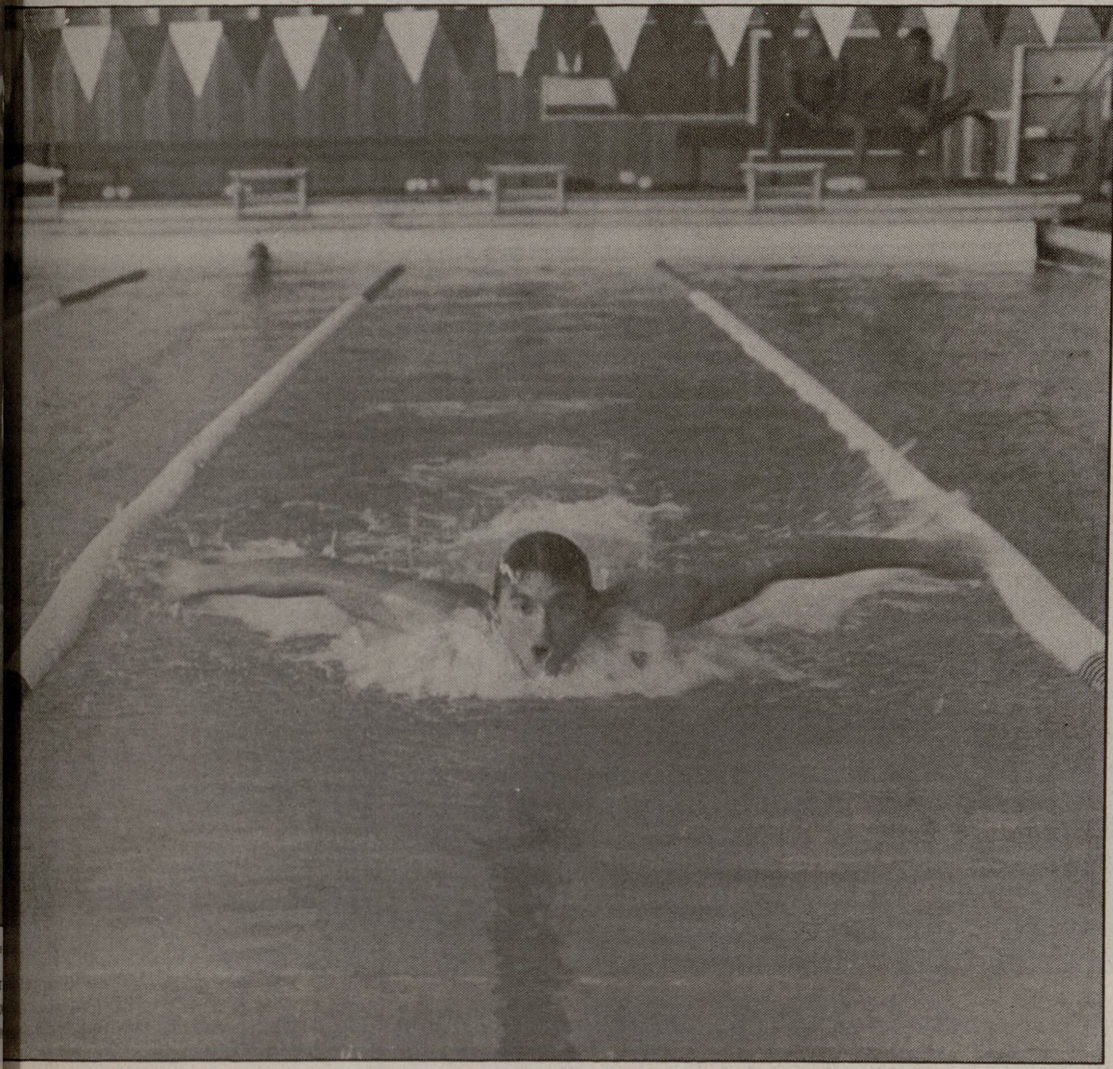

Edwards takes 2 state titles; Shively places second twice

Texas A&M University employee Kay Edwards reaffirmed her dominance in Texas canoeing and kayaking by taking two state titles Saturday at Dickinson Bayou in Dickinson.

Competing against teams from Texas, Louisiana and Arkansas, Edwards took the one-person women's kayak competition and teamed up with Precilla Tyrone of Friendswood to take the C-2 canoe title (doubles canoeing). Edwards had never raced with Tyrone before.

Edwards later doubled up with Texas A&M professor Mike Shively to finish second in the mixed canoeing competition.

Shively, who won the grueling Texas Water Safari in early June, also took second place in the men's aluminum canoe class, teaming up with Robin Harris.

Local boater John Bugge also placed in the championships, taking a third place in the men's solo canoe division.

Shively and Edwards, both nationally accomplished competitors in both kayak and canoe, have teamed up several times in the past to win championships, and have won several individual trophies.

"There was a lot of competition in this championship," said Edwards. "It was good to see that much competition coming to our Texas championships."

Edwards said the heat along with the length of the courses were major problems.

"I was tired and hurting after a few races," she said.

She noted that in the finals of the men's aluminum doubles competition, Shively and Harris had problems because they had water splashed into their boat by their competitors.

"They were boat to boat with the other guys," she said, "and when you're paddling hard the bow wake of the other boat can come right into your boat."

"Mike and Robin were paddling

hard because they had five to six gallons of water in their boat, at six to eight pounds a gallon. That's a lot of weight to be carrying. They did very good to finish like they did."
